Milwaukee memorabilia.

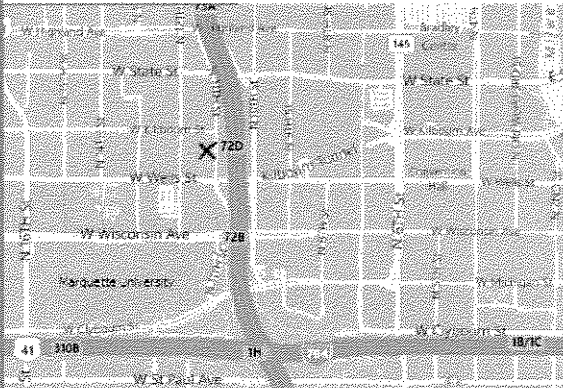
The Museum honors his legacy as a local business leader, attorney and philanthropist.
