As you know, the City of Milwaukee's Common Council has a number of concerns regarding the placement of sex offenders in the City by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. On June 12, 2014, the Common Council's Steering and Rules Committee will be considering an ordinance, sponsored by Ald. Zielinski, relating to restrictions for sex offenders in the City. The meeting will be held in City Hall's Room 301-B at 1:30 p.m.

I'm writing to invite you to appear at the meeting to provide the Committee with information regarding the Department's placement of sex offenders in the City. If you are able to appear at the Committee meeting, I would like you to address the following questions:

- What role will your office play in resolving the problems that currently exist?
- Is your office actively working to correct the problems?
- What can the City of Milwaukee do to assist your office in resolving the problems?

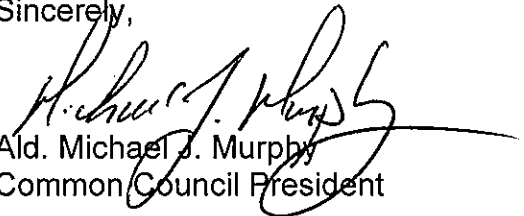
