1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Milwaukee Police Department is the host agency for the Southeast Wisconsin Threat Analysis Center (STAC), an all crimes, all threats, information sharing fusion center for the eight counties of Southeast Wisconsin including Milwaukee, Waukesha, Racine, Kenosha, Walworth Ozaukee, Washington, and Dodge. Funds will be used by the Milwaukee Police Department to fund base pay, fringe benefits, and overtime hours for one (1) STAC Infrastructure Protection (IP) Intelligence Analyst, one (1) STAC Homeland Security (HS) Intelligence Analyst, and two (2) STAC Training and Outreach Coordinators for 7.5 months from July 1, 2026 to February 13, 2027. Funds will also support a portion of travel costs for the two grant funded Intelligence Analysts to attend the International Association of Law Enforcement Intelligence Analysts Conference in April of 2027.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The purpose of the grant is to improve STAC capacity to provide detection, prevention, deterrence, and response to crime and terrorism. The IP and HS Intelligence Analysts will coordinate risk, threat, and vulnerability assessments. The Training and Outreach Coordinators will strengthen community partnerships, increase participation in the Fusion Liaison Officer (FLO) program, and improve information sharing related to homeland security priorities across all program areas.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

The total grant award of \$210,755.00 with a grantor amount of \$210,755.00 will support one (1) STAC Infrastructure Protection (IP) Intelligence Analyst position, one (1) STAC Homeland Security (HS) Intelligence Analyst position, and two (2) STAC Training and Outreach Coordinator positions. No Department match is required. Position authority will expire on 6/30/2027 unless the Homeland Security – WEM/STAC Analysts Positions 2024 grant is extended.
