Subject: Summary of ARRA Grant Funding

The following provides information requested by the Finance and Personnel Committee at the October 2, 2009 budget hearing on the Grant and Aid Fund 2010 proposed budget. The Committee wanted a summary of the grant funding the City has received or will be applying for through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.

Departments are currently entering their ARRA grant Information on the Grant Information/Analysis reporting tool on the city's intranet. Grant Information can be viewed at http://mint/grants.

The Grant Information/Analysis page provides an "Executive Report of City of Milwaukee Grants". The grant information provided in this Executive Report can be sorted by ARRA grants. The information currently shows 47 ARRA grant applications, with total potential funding of \$150.5 million.

The status of the ARRA applications is shown in the table below:

As these data show, 24 grant applications have been awarded or approved with funding of \$45.1 million. Another 16 applications with potential funding of \$87.3 million are in process. There were seven applications, with funding of \$18.2 million that have been denied.

The detailed list of ARRA applications, including the department making the application and a description of the grant and its purpose, is attached to this memorandum.

Departments will be updating the ARRA grant information in the Grant Information/Analysis reporting tool. Members of the Finance and Personnel Committee can use the "Executive Report" in the Grant Information/Analysis intranet page to monitor the ARRA grant applications.
