REASON FOR REQUEST:

Brian Lewandowski, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a marked police motorcycle that was stopped on West Silver Spring Drive at the red traffic signal at the intersection with North 68<sup>th</sup> Street. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling eastbound on West Silver Spring Drive, failed to stop and rear-ended the police motorcycle, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. §62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's uninsured motorist self-insurance plan.

Officer Lewandowski sustained injuries to his right knee, head and face. The treating physician indicated that the right knee injury is permanent. The medical expenses and lost wages total \$47,103.01.
