WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukee was approached by Robert F. Tambellini and Jack H. White of 1726-28 E. North Avenue with a request to vacate a portion of the alley west of their property; and

WHEREAS, Milwaukee County has been asked to join in the petition to vacate the alley as, upon completion of the alley vacation, the County will own a piece of former railroad right-of-way that is adjacent to the Oak Leaf Bike Trail and under the alley that is proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS, when vacated, ownership of a 7' wide section of the west side of the alley that is adjacent to the parkland would normally revert back to Milwaukee County; and

WHEREAS, because the 7' wide section has long been used as an alley and was never used for park purposes, the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture does not wish to accept this land for park purposes and it is of no other use to Milwaukee County for now and in the future; and

WHEREAS, Robert F. Tambellini and Jack H. White wish to own the entire portion of the alley to be vacated including the 7' section adjacent to the parkland and have agreed to assume all expenses resulting from the alley vacation; and

WHEREAS, because the land likely has little or no value and the cost to prepare the necessary legal documents would cost more than the land is worth, Milwaukee County agrees to give up ownership of this parcel and will convey by quit claim deed the land directly to Robert F. Tambellini and Jack H. White immediately upon its reversion back to Milwaukee County; now, therefore,

46 47 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive and the County Clerk are hereby authorized to convey by quit claim deed the said land reverting back to 48 49 Milwaukee County after the alley vacation to Robert F.
