This is to notify you that on January 6, 2004 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application as Agent for Utopia, Inc. for a Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement (Cabaret/Niteclub) license for the premises at 162 West Wisconsin Avenue, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Pure") be approved with a seventy-five (75) day suspension. 




