If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. INITIAL INVESTIGATION

This report was written by Police Officer Emily MARKERT, assigned to District Six, Late Shift.

On this day, I was assigned to Squad 6340. I was dressed in full Milwaukee Police uniform and AXON body camera, and operating in a fully marked, black and white, Milwaukee Police Department squad, vehicle 069, which is equipped with a MDVR system. This system records audio and video evidence which do not pertain to this incident.

On Sunday, February 14, 2020 at approximately 1:46AM, Squad 6340 was dispatched to the address 2416 S Kinnickinnic Ave, which is in the City and County of Milwaukee, in the State of Wisconsin, to investigate a Battery complaint.

On scene, I spoke with Jacob A MCCONNELL (M/W, 02-21-1987) who I observed sitting behind a counter holding an ice pack up to his shoulder. MCCONNELL stated he did not remember the physical altercation that took place or who the subject was that assaulted him. MCCONNELL stated he is an employee of the bowling alley and was on duty at the time of the incident. MCCONNELL stated he did not want any medical attention and refused medical attention with Milwaukee Fire Department on scene. MCCONNELL stated he did not want to go to the hospital because he does not have any health

insurance.

The bartender on duty, identified as Graeme W MCDONALD (M/W, 03-04-1989) stated he did not observe the incident but would spend the night with MCCONNELL to make sure he would be okay. MCDONALD stated there is video surveillance inside the bowling alley but only the owner can retrieve it.

A witness on scene, Ryan C FISCHER M/W, 08-30-1995 stated he observed a white male wearing a red track jacket, later identified as Brendon J HERMANSON M/W, 08-09-1968 body slam MCCONNELL causing pain and injury to his shoulder and head.

Follow up requested by day shift captain car to retrieve video.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 7/13/2021 at 1:35 PM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
