If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. 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**4. Corporate officer Jeffrey Kovacovich has an open warrant with the Muskego Police Department for Failure to Pay. N1072525.**  
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5. On 06/24/13, at 12:45 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1135 N Water Street for a Fight complaint. Police spoke with the bar manager, David Kuklin, who stated there were a group of females in the front area of the bar who were verbally arguing with each other for an unknown reason, when the fight became physical. Kuklin stated his security broke up the fight and escorted the females out of the bar. All parties fled prior to police arrival.

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6. On 12/15/2013 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGillcuddy's Tavern). Investigation revealed that a fight took place inside the business and an individual who works as security was struck in the back of the head with a glass during the fight. The victim received 6 staples in the back of the head as a result of this incident. Milwaukee police incident report #133500003 filed.

7. On 02/02/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a fight complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGillcuddy's Tavern). Investigation revealed two patrons of the business were involved in an altercation. Both patrons were cited.

8. On 05/03/2014 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillycuddy's Tavern (133-1137 North Water Street). The police aide was turned away when she could not provide proof she had turned 21 years of age.

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9. On 10/27/2014 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 740 West Wisconsin Avenue #103. The victim, James Newkirk, told officers he had been at McGillycuddy's Bar (1135 North Water Street) the previous evening (10/26/2015) and someone punched him in the face. Mr. Newkirk stated he was intoxicated and has absolutely no recollection of what happened. He further stated the manager of the bar gave him a ride to St. Mary's hospital where he was diagnosed with a concussion, a fractured right eye socket, and two broken teeth. Officers spoke to the general manager of the business, Tate Winckler, who stated he was aware of a fight the previous night because the manager told him about it. Mr. Winckler also told officers there are no working cameras inside the bar, that the manager was currently unavailable for interview and that no one from the business had called police. Milwaukee police incident report # 143000136 filed.

10. On 11/01/2014 Matthew Sokol walked into Milwaukee police district #1 to report that his wallet had been stolen from his rear pocket the previous evening while at McGillicuddy's (1135 North Water Street). Mr. Sokol also told officers he had no idea who took it. Milwaukee police incident report #143050071 filed.
11. On 01/18/2015 Milwaukee police responded to a battery complaint at 1135 North Water Street (McGillicuddy's). The victim stated he was escorting an unruly patron from the business when he was punched in the face by another patron. Both patrons were apprehended and cited.
12. On 02/19/2015 Milwaukee police conducted a licensed premise check at 1133 North Water Street (McGillicuddy's) and provided Patrick Murthey was a packet of tavern related ordinances.
13. On 02/27/2015 a 19 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's (1133 North Water Street) but was denied when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.
14. On 08/08/2015 a 20 year old Milwaukee police aide, working in conjunction with Milwaukee police, attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's (1133 North Water Street) but was denied when she could not produce proof she had attained the legal drinking age of 21.

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15. On 10/23/2015 Milwaukee police, while inside McGillicuddy's Tavern (1135 North Water Street) on a Code Red Deployment, were advised by a security guard that he had been stabbed. Investigation revealed two patrons of the business had been told to leave by security. One of the patrons dropped his right hand and thrust it back up, striking the security guard in the left side of his stomach. The security guard saw blood and realized he had a laceration to his abdomen. This laceration required 3 sutures. This same patron punched another security guard in the eye. Milwaukee police incident report #152970015 filed.
16. On 01/17/2016 Milwaukee police were flagged down by the manager at McGillicuddys tavern (1135 North Water Street) who stated there was a fight involving as many as 15 people at the business. Officers observed numerous subjects involved in a fight and cited 4 individuals for disorderly conduct.
17. On 02/04/2016 Milwaukee police conducted a training course at The Winchester (2321 North Murray Avenue) regarding the use and identification of fake driver licenses and other identification for gaining entry into taverns. A representative of McGillicuddy's Bar and Grill was present at this training.

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18. On 10/15/2016 at 2:35am officers arrested subjects in front of McGillicuddy's tavern, 1135 N. Water St. The subjects were not related to the tavern but the manager assisted the officers with retrieval of video surveillance which aided the investigation.
19. On 03/30/2017 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 1. An underage Police Aid attempted to gain entry to McGillicuddy's, at 1133 N. water St. The Police Aid was denied by security at the door.

20. On 06/25/2017 officers observed two subjects being pushed out the front door at McGillicuddy's, 1135 N. water St. The subjects began fighting and it took several officers to stop the fight and arrest the subjects. A review of video surveillance inside showed the same two subjects fighting inside then being pushed outside.
  
21. On 07/23/2017 a subject walked in to District one to file a complaint of a battery that occurred at McGillicuddy's. 1135 N. Water St. The victim stated he was at McGillicuddy's with a female friend when a subject grabbed her arm. He stepped toward the subject and asked him why he grabbed her arm. The subject then punched him in the face. The bar separated the parties, sending one set to the front and one to the back. The manager stated he thought it was an argument and didn't realize anyone was hurt until after the parties left. The victim was treated at St Mary's hospital and the lacerations required 13 stitches to close. MPD report filed.

This report is written by Police Officer Cullin Weiskopf, assigned to District One, Late Power Shift.

On the evening of Thursday March 30th, 2017 through the morning of Friday, March 31st, 2017 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There were three teams that were part of this initiative. Each team had an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer or Sergeant monitoring from a short distance. The Police Aide for each team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. Police Aide Monica Zarinana-Mayorga (PS 026070, 11/28/1996) and PO Sarah Beland (PS 019704) were in plainclothes while PO Seth Edwards (PS 024600) were in full uniform.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments the Police Aides and Police Officers were given instructions. All plainclothes members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. The Police Officers were directed to produce ID's, but the underage Police Aides were directed to not produce any form of identification. It was explained that the Police Aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes Police Officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages.

On March 30th, 2017 at 11:10 PM, PO Beland and PA Zarinana-Mayorga attempted to gain entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, McGillicuddy's, located at 1133 N. Water St. PA Zarinana-Mayorg was refused entry by security for the tavern.

On May 10th, 2017 at 12:04 AM, PO Cullin Weiskopf informed Mark Ryterski that the tavern had successfully passed the initiative.

This report is written by PO Thomas FRANK, assigned to District 1, Power shift. On Sunday, June 25th, 2017, at 12:49AM, while assigned to Sq. 1442, I observed a fight in front of 1135 N. Water St. (McGuillicuddy's). I observed several subjects get pushed out the front door of the tavern, and onto the sidewalk just in front of the location. At that time, I observed a subject later identified as, Dylan C. CRAFTON, B/M, 5/1/92, punching another subject in the head and face. I, along with numerous other officers broke up the fight, and two subjects were taken into custody, one of which was CRAFTON. The other subject was the individual that CRAFTON was fighting with and he was identified as, Adam J. PIPP, W/M, 5/20/92. PO Adam ISLEB reviewed video from inside of the tavern which showed both PIPP and CRAFTON fighting, throwing punches, and causing a large disruption inside of the tavern. When both CRAFTON and PIPP were pushed out of the tavern, both subjects continued to fight. CRAFTON and PIPP were issued citations.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Thomas FRANK, assigned to District 1, Power shift.

On Sunday, July 23rd, 2017, while assigned to the Police Administration Building Security Desk, PO Derek ERTL took a walk in battery complaint from, Kenneth W. ANDERSON, B/M, 12/08/1992. ANDERSON explained that on 07/23/2017 at approximately 2:00 AM, he was in McGillicuddy's bar located at 1135 N Water St. with his friends.

ANDERSON stated at that time, his friends and him were inside McGillicuddy's and they were near the center of the main bar. ANDERSON stated his friend was holding her phone to her ear and he was standing next to her. ANDERSON stated at this time, the suspect grabbed his friend's hand, that was holding her phone, and pulled her towards him.

ANDERSON described the suspect as an unknown black male, approximately 30-35 years old, approximately 6'01" to 6'03" tall, approximately 220lbs, with an unknown clothing description but possibly wearing a blue shirt. ANDERSON stated this action done by the suspect made him step towards the suspect ask him, "Why did you grab her? Don't grab her". ANDERSON stated the suspect then stated, "You touching me?" to which ANDERSON stated he replied, "No man, but why'd you grab her?" ANDERSON stated the suspect then intentionally struck him one time with a closed fist to his forehead without consent.

ANDERSON stated this action caused him to fall back into some chairs and tables across the room from the bar and when he stood back up, he felt blood running down his face from his forehead. Due to the strike, ANDERSON received two lacerations to his forehead. One was approximately 1.5 inches long and the other was approximately 1 inch long. Both lacerations run vertically near the center of his forehead. ANDERSON then stated a bartender then told him he could sit in the booths adjacent from the main entrance and gave him a towel for his forehead.

ANDERSON'S friend called for an Uber car to pick them up and they left McGillicuddy's through the main door and waited for a couple minutes outside for the Uber car to pick them up.

ANDERSON stated he then had the Uber driver take them to St. Mary's Hospital where he was admitted into the ER and received 13 stitches from Dr. Jeffrey MERLIN for his two lacerations at 2:43 AM.

On Monday, 7/24/17, while assigned to Sq. 1442, I conducted follow-up at the location of 1135 N. Water St. (McGillicuddy's) regarding this incident.

Upon my arrival I spoke to the general manager, Thomas J. TOMES, W/M, 12/26/81. TOMES stated that he working when this incident occurred. TOMES stated at approximately 2:15AM, there was some sort of fight that took place near the middle of the main bar on the first floor. TOMES stated he observed what looked like two groups of individuals pushing and shoving each other. TOMES and his staff immediately intervened and separated the parties. TOMES stated that one group was pushed towards the exit near the outdoor patio (west end of bar), while the other group was pushed towards the front of the bar (east side of the bar). TOMES stated he did not realize at the time that anyone was injured, and that his staff and him were just attempting to separate all parties, to prevent anything further from happening.

TOMES stated after the groups were separated, he observed one subject holding a towel on his head, and observed that he was bleeding. TOMES stated he allowed this subject and his friends to sit inside of the bar, and asked the subject if he wanted medical attention. TOMES stated the subject told him that he did not want any medical attention, and that him and his friends were going to take an Uber. TOMES stated the injured subject and his friends then exited the bar, and got into an unknown vehicle.

TOMES stated he or his staff never saw anyone throw a punch, and that he just assumed it was an argument, and the beginning of a possible fight. TOMES stated he did not realize anyone was injured until after one of the groups involved was already out of the bar.

TOMES stated he did not personally know who may have punched and injured the victim, and did not know anyone involved in the fight. TOMES described the subject that appeared to be the main aggressor in the group that was escorted out the rear of the bar as a H/M, or bi-racial male, in his 20's, 6'1-6'2, 275lbs, wearing a possible blue colored button down shirt.

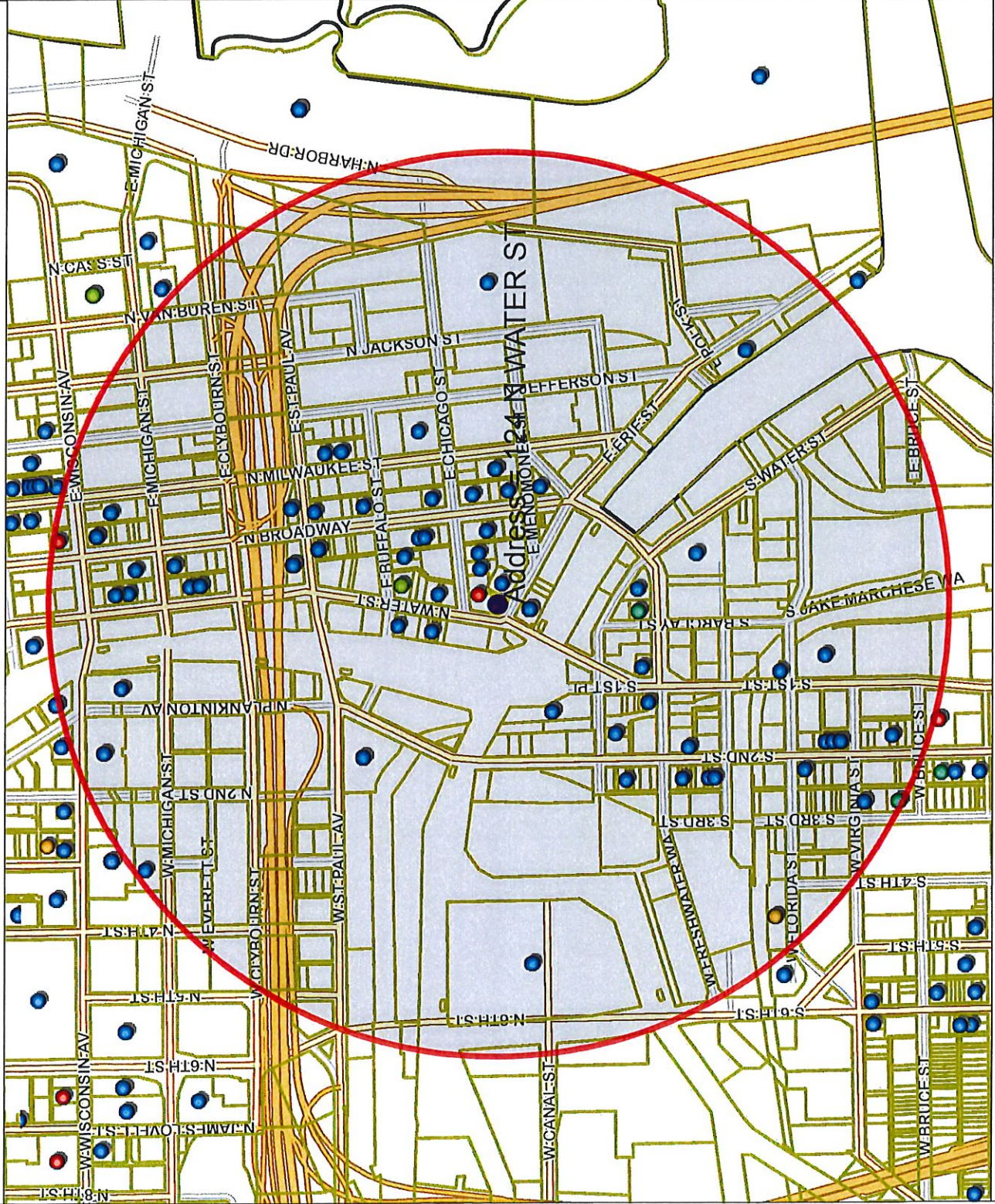
