1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services in conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has identified West Nile Virus (WNV) as an emerging pathogen in Wisconsin during the Fall of 2001. The Milwaukee Health Department was integral in collecting bird specimens for analysis of WNV during the initial detection of the disease and has since developed public information and outreach on the epidemiology of the virus in Milwaukee County. These monies will be used to fund a .5 FTE staff in the Milwaukee Health Department to continue coordination of bird surveillance as well as enhance overall surveillance of the disease in both mosquito and human populations. The monies will also be used to provide some public education and outreach to healthcare providers as well as the general public through website, public hotline and printed materials.
