- 4. On 06/04/09 at 1:47 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 11400 W Silver Spring for a Battery complaint. Police spoke to the victim who stated she was at Silk when another patron came up to her spat in her face and also made threats to harm her. Security removed the suspect from the tavern and officers issued the suspect a citation for disorderly conduct.
- 5. On 04/21/12 at 2:24 pm, Milwaukee police investigated an accident complaint at 11400 W Silver Spring Drive. Investigation revealed a patron had damage done to his auto while he was inside the club. Police spoke with management who stated that the car was parked out of surveillance range and did not capture this incident. A report was filed.
- 6. On 05/13/12, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check and found no violations.
- 7. On 05/19/12 at 2:15 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check and found no violations.
- 8. On 07/06/12 at 12:20 am, Milwaukee police responded to a Battery complaint at 11400 W Silver Spring. Investigation revealed an employee, who was highly intoxicated, was causing a disturbance and had slapped two patrons inside the club. Other club employees' took the subject to a back room and attempted to call her a cab, but the subject refused and left on her own, falling several times. A security guard filmed some of the incident on his cell phone, which was played for police. Police did speak with the subject who refused to talk with police and hung up on the officer. There were no recording surveillance cameras inside the establishment.
- On 09/01/12 at 1:15 am, Milwaukee police conducted a License Premise Check at 11400 W Silver Spring. No violations were observed.

10. On 01/01/2015 occupants of a vehicle responded to Silk to pick up an individual that was an employee there. One of the occupants of the vehicle commanded a dog in the car to attack the person they had just picked up. The victim was able to exit the vehicle and ran back into Silk. An armed Security Guard employed by Silk Exotic fired a handgun at the dog. The Investigation revealed the Security Guard, Laderle R. Williams, is a convicted felon from a case on 12/05/14 and was prohibited from possessing a gun. Members of District Four had a meeting with Jon Ferraro regarding this incident. Mr. Ferraro stated he hired the security guard nine years ago and fired him once he was informed by the police. Milwaukee police incident report #150130080 filed.

This report is written by P.O. Tracey Geniesse assigned District Four, Day Shift, Community Liaison Officer.

On Wednesday 1/14/15, Sgt. James Bunker advised me to conduct follow up with Det. Troy Jankowski in regards to an incident that occurred on Jan.1, 2015. The incident took place at Silk Exotic located at 11400 W. Silver Spring Rd

I spoke with Det. Jankowski, who stated he needed a PA-33 filed regarding a shots fired complaint involving Laderle R. Williams B/M 08/18/73, who was employed at Silk as a private security officer. Det. Jankowski stated there was a previous incident at another location in District Five area regarding a shooting (inc# 150010002). The suspect (Doyle, Kali M. W/F 01/05/94), who was the passenger in the car, (driven by the victim) went to Silk to pick up a friend who was working. After leaving the club, Doyle along with the victim (driver) and the friend that was picked up were all in the vehicle. While in the vehicle Doyle commanded the dog to attack the victim, which it did. The victim was able to exit the vehicle and ran into the club while the dog chased her. The armed Security Officer (Laderle R Williams B/M 08/18/73) witnessed the dog chasing the victim and he opened the front door and fired his gun toward the direction of the dog. It was not clear to me if the dog was shot or not. But it was later determined that Williams was a convicted felon and should not have been in possession of a firearm. Doyle then drove off in the victim's vehicle, which was later reported stolen (150020130) and recovered in the city of Wauwatosa.

Det. Jankowski conducted a search of MPD and open source records including Wisconsin Court System Circuit Court Access, Consolidated Court Automation Programs (CCAP) for WILLIAMS. He located Case 2014CF000688 for Laderle R. WILLIAMS that specified on 12-05-2015 he was notified of, "Defendant was advised of constitutional rights and maximum penalties, waived all rights, and plead GUILTY. Defendant examined as to the plea. Plea Questionnaire/Waiver of Rights and Addendum received and filed. Stipulation by parties to the Criminal Complaint as a factual basis to sustain the plea. Court found the defendant guilty. Judgment of conviction entered. Court advised defendant that as a convicted felon he may never possess any gun or other firearms."

Myself and P.O. Carrie Resnick had a meeting with Jon Ferraro (Owner) on Wednesday, 1/14/15 at 2:15pm. The meeting took place at Silk Exotic, 11400 W. Slver Spring Dr. We were the only three present during this meeting. I asked Ferraro if he was aware of the incident that took place on Jan. 1st, he stated yes. He stated Det. Jankowski along with a few others came to the club and spoke about it, at which time Ferraro provided video footage to him.

Ferraro stated he hired Williams about nine years ago. He stated Williams was working for a Security Company at that time and he was shown all documentation verifing William's CCW permit as well as paper work showing that he licensed and bonded. William's then began to work private security for Silk a short time later. There was never any problem with Williams. Ferraro stated he was not aware of Williams being convited of a felony case on December 5th, 2014.

Ferraro stated once he was notifed of Mr. Williams status by Det. Jankowski, he immediately terminated Williams and fully cooperated with the Milwaukee Police Department. He also stated all of the subjects involved have been banned from the property. He is willing to work with the Milwaukee Police Department and will consider any suggestions to keeping his business safe.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

On 11/08/2013 at approximately 7:30pm, Milwaukee Police attempted to conduct a license premise check at 3710 W Lincoln Av, Wisco Sports Bar & Grill because they had information that the tavern was operating without any valid licenses. A check with LIRA database confirmed all license had expired on 11/01/2013. While there, officers observed the front door was locked and a subject walking in the establishment that would not come to the door to unlock it. On the same day approximately 11:08pm, an officer in plain clothes responded to the location and was able to walk into the bar and was met by security and asked for id. Uniformed officers as well as a supervisor met the officer at the location and conducted a license premise check. The investigation revealed, approximately 12 patrons inside, with open alcohol containers on the bar, a cook working in the kitchen, and a DJ performing. The licensed bartender agreed to close the establishment once he was told that all licenses were expired. Upon speaking with the last known licensee on 11/11/2013, TRAN via phone he insisted he had nothing to do with the tavern for some time and the only person with a key to the tavern is WHIGHAM who "keeps an eye on the place for him". The applicant, DENT was also spoken to via phone who denied operating the tavern and that his lease agreement did not start until 12/01/2013. On 11/12/2013 at approximately 12:15pm, TRAN and WHIGHAM met with officers at District 2 to discuss what had happened on 11/082013. WHIGHAM said he was hosting a private party listening session for a CD

label he represents. When asked about serving alcohol without a Class B tavern license he said he purchased alcohol by himself and was giving it away, but admitted a DJ was performing. WHIGHAM admitted to meeting DENT "1 or 2 times" but denied operating the tavern on his behalf. WHIGHAM was cited for:



AGREEMENT RELATING TO STORAGE OF FOOD IN A PRIVATE RESIDENCE

Food storage by a vending machine owner or distributor in a private residence is limited as follows.

NOTE: No other food dealers may store food in a private residence.

- Prior to issuance of a license, the storage area must be inspected and in compliance with the following:
 - A. Food storage in the home must be limited to commercially packaged, non-potentially hazardous snack foods such as gums candies, and chips.
 - B. All food must be stored in its original container. There can be no storage of unwrapped bulk food products or removal of product from its original package for repackaging of any kind.
 - C. No food can be stored in any room used as living or sleeping quarters. Food storage must be in a separate room, used exclusively for food storage. No other non-food items can be stored in this room. The room must also be equipped with a tight-fitting, self-closing door. No pets are to be kept or allowed in the food storage area.
 - D. No food can be stored in a garage or other buildings outside the dwelling unit.
 - E. Foods must be stored off the floor and away from the wall in rodent/insect proof containers (i.e., plastic or metal containers with tight-fitting lids).
 - F. There shall be no sales made in or around the dwelling unit.
 - G. This approval is only applicable to vending machine owners, peddlers, and distributors without retail operations or warehouses, and storage is limited to what can be sold in a week's time.
 - H. Operator must agree to unannounced annual inspection of the storage area by the Milwaukee Health Department as a condition of licensing. Violation of any of the above requirements is grounds for denial or revocation of a license.
 - I. Operator must have a Statement of Home Occupation on file with the Department of Building Inspection.
 - J. Vehicles used in transporting foods are also subject to inspection and approval by the Health Department.
 - K. No food can be stored in an attic unless the attic is properly finished and ventilated.
