There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Dear Mr. Chen,

We have received a renewal application changing the trade name and menu of the business at 770 N Milwaukee St. According to the enclosed *Urban Milwaukee* article, Ninja MKE closed in November 2023. Additionally you are paraphrased as saying "the lower-level karaoke, a feature of the previous establishment, will remain unchanged".

According to the article, two license violations have occurred. First, a Public Entertainment Premises License is required for karaoke. Second, section 90-10.5 of the Milwaukee Code states any person holding an alcohol beverage license under this chapter shall surrender the license upon ceasing operations. You applied for and withdrew an application for public entertainment. You did not surrender the license upon ceasing operations.

Given this information, you must file a new a Public Entertainment Premises Application before the Licenses Committee can consider your renewal. You should be prepared to speak to the committee as to why the license was not surrendered. If you wish to submit a written statement you may do so via hardcopy or electronically by emailing [license@milwaukee.gov](mailto:license@milwaukee.gov). Visit [www.milwaukee.gov/licensespermits](http://www.milwaukee.gov/licensespermits) for an application for a Public Entertainment Premises License. Three-story restaurant has new name, will move from sushi to Louisiana cajun style.

Following the closure of [Ninja MKE](#) in November 2023, owner [Li Chai Chen](#) is reimagining the three-story restaurant space at [770 N. Milwaukee St.](#) While the new venture will depart from the sushi focus of its predecessor, seafood is still on the menu.

[Harbor Catch Seafood Boil](#) is set to open in the coming months, bringing a Milwaukee twist to the Louisiana Cajun tradition.

"There's not much seafood in that area, but there are a lot of meats," Chen said, referencing a plethora of steakhouses in the [East Town](#) neighborhood. Customers expressed interest in a spot

for seafood boils, Chen said, and he was eager to deliver.

The family-style meal, popular in shellfish-rich regions of the South and Eastern U.S., typically includes shrimp, crab, lobster, clams, mussels or crawfish, along with vegetables like corn and potatoes. The ingredients are cooked in a seasoned broth and traditionally served without dishes, poured directly onto a paper-lined table for diners to enjoy with their hands.

It's worth noting that Wisconsin — particularly Door County — has its own version of the culinary tradition: fish boils. These typically include whitefish, onions and potatoes boiled in a simple broth seasoned with salt and pepper and "scalded" with hot oil or butter at the end of cooking.

Chen plans to offer seafood boils in the restaurant's main dining area, located on the ground level. Given city approval, the space, which also includes a large bar, would feature a selection of alcoholic beverages for guests.

The lower-level karaoke area, a feature of the previous establishment, will remain unchanged, with private rooms available for parties, Chen said. He also noted plans for an additional concept on the building's upper level, previously a hibachi area, though he is still finalizing the details.

Chen said the restaurant's current setup will transition easily, and he has no plans for construction. Harbor Catch Seafood Boil aims to open within the next several months, ideally near the beginning of spring.

A license renewal application for the restaurant is pending before the [Milwaukee Common Council](#).

Chen, an established restaurateur, also operates sushi Ninja Hibachi Sushi Steakhouse in Menomonee Falls and Ninja Japanese Steakhouse in West Bend.



The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/20/2025 at 9:45 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or [stasst5@milwaukee.gov](mailto:stasst5@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## **Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:**

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**


