1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The USEPA in coordination with the WDNR has made available monies to local jurisdictions to be used for the implementation of bacterial monitoring at Wisconsin public beaches. This monitoring is to be conducted on a seasonal basis and include appropriate public notification by the local jurisdiction if beaches fail to meet State water and health guidelines (State BEACH Act). These monies will be used by the MHD to conduct daily testing at three Lake Michigan beaches located in the City of Milwaukee between May-September. The monies will also be used to purchase field equipment necessary to evaluate water quality on-site.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

This program is consistent with City-wide strategic goals and department objectives related to assurance of environmental quality within the City of Milwaukee and protection of the public health from waterborne communicable disease.
