PLEASE NOTE: This hearing relates to the property within the boundary shown on the map on the reverse side of this notice. If your property is not within the zoning boundary, then you are receiving this notice because your property address is within 250 feet of the subject site.

PERSON OF INTEREST:

The Common Council has referred File No. 252189 to the City Plan Commission for recommendation. This file relates to the change in zoning from Two-Family Residential, RT4, and Local Business, LB2, for the properties located at 410 W. Concordia Avenue and 3301 and 3307 N. Vel R. Phillips Avenue to Detailed Planned Development, DPD, and the 1st Amendment to the DPD known as Bader Philanthropies to add the subject sites to the DPD that currently includes 3300 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, on the north side of West Concordia Avenue, east of North Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, in the 6th Aldermanic District.

Bader Philanthropies' global headquarters has been located at 3300 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, zoned DPD, since 2018, and among its own functions, frequently provides space within its building for community organizations to convene. MLK, LLC acquired three additional properties adjacent to it (410 N. Concordia Avenue, and 3301 and 3307 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive) and plans to construct an accessory parking lot on a portion of the land to help with parking needs. The remaining space will be utilized as additional open space for Bader Philanthropies. This file will change the zoning of the three newly acquired properties to DPD to be consistent the existing zoning of Bader Philanthropies' headquarters, and will approve the plans for the accessory parking lot and open space. **Please refer to the reverse side of this notice for map details.**

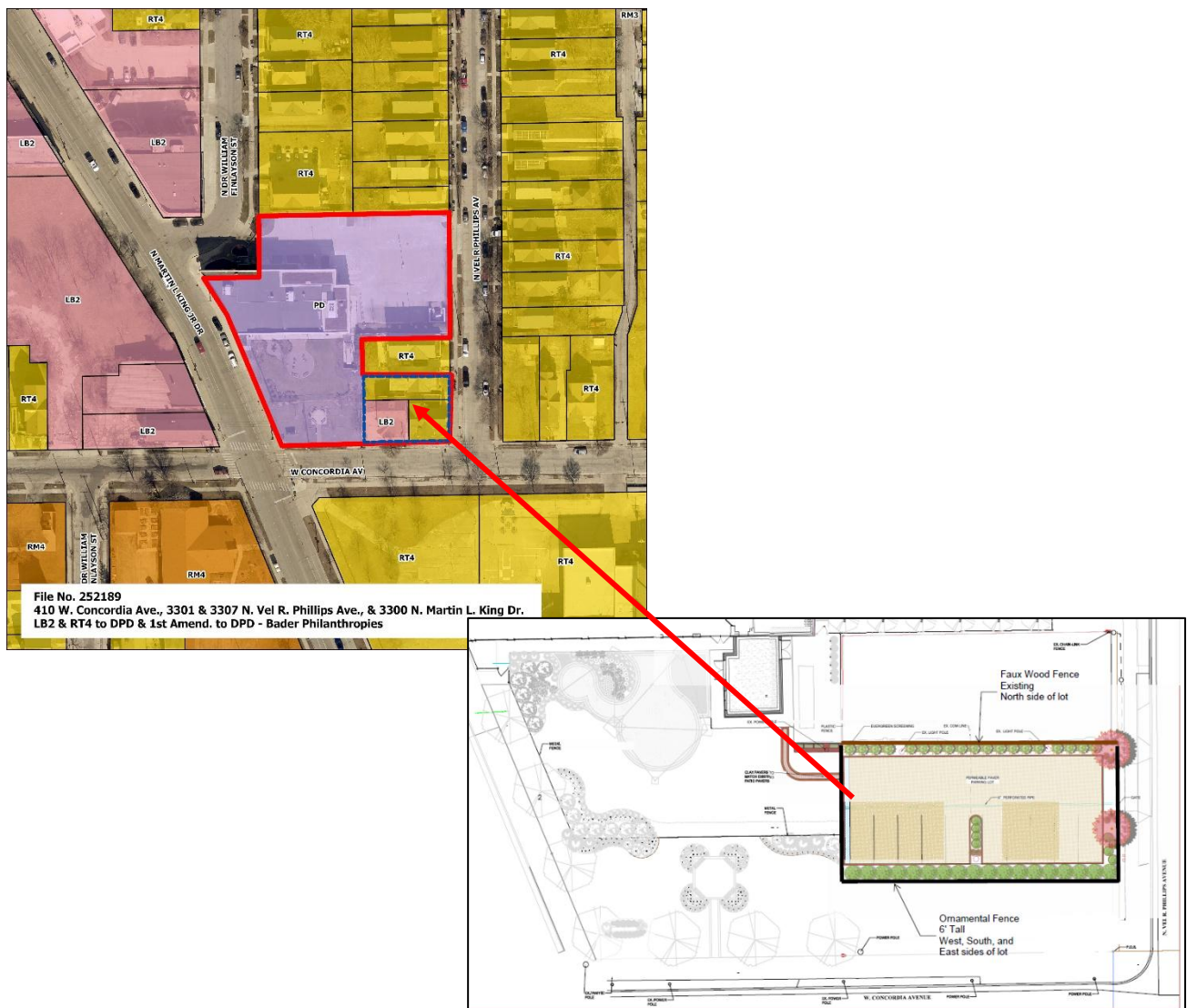
