

Dear Council Members:

Claimant, Angela McKinnie, 5723 North 63<sup>rd</sup> Street, Milwaukee, WI 53218, alleges that the City of Milwaukee Police Department did not properly investigate her complaint when summoned on April 9, 2004 after she sustained injuries from unknown actors at 4125 West Lloyd Street. She claims damages in the amount of \$310,000.00.

Our investigation reveals the Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) was summoned to 5723 North 63<sup>rd</sup> Street on the subject date regarding a "Battery Complaint." Ms. McKinnie stated that this incident occurred at 4125 West Lloyd Street. The MPD did call for medical attention for Ms. McKinnie's injuries, but she refused medical treatment. The MPD investigated this incident and Ms. McKinnie was advised to contact the MPD with any further information. The disposition of the investigation was pended until further information was received. The MPD followed standard procedures with this matter. Moreover, the MPD is immune from liability arising out of the manner in which it conducts investigations because investigations are a discretionary activity. As such, the City cannot accept liability. Therefore, we recommend that his claim be denied.
