Regarding: Your Class A Malt & Class A Liquor License Application as agent for "Blaine PL Xpress Pantry Inc" for "Express Pantry" at 2719 N Blaine Pl. 

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.


You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

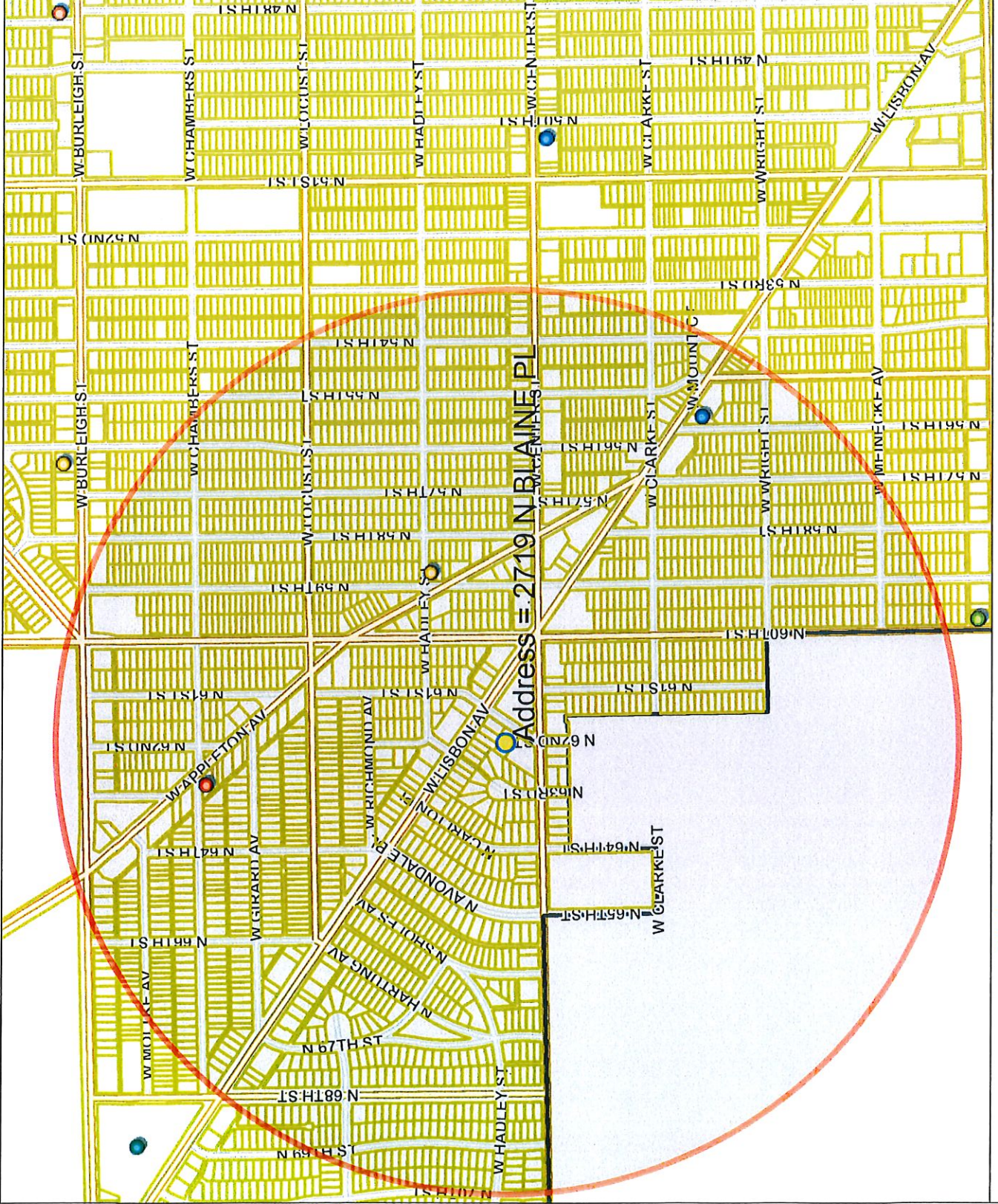

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/3/2017 at 10:00 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

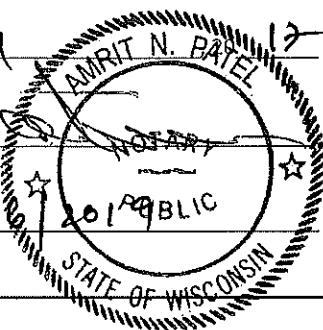

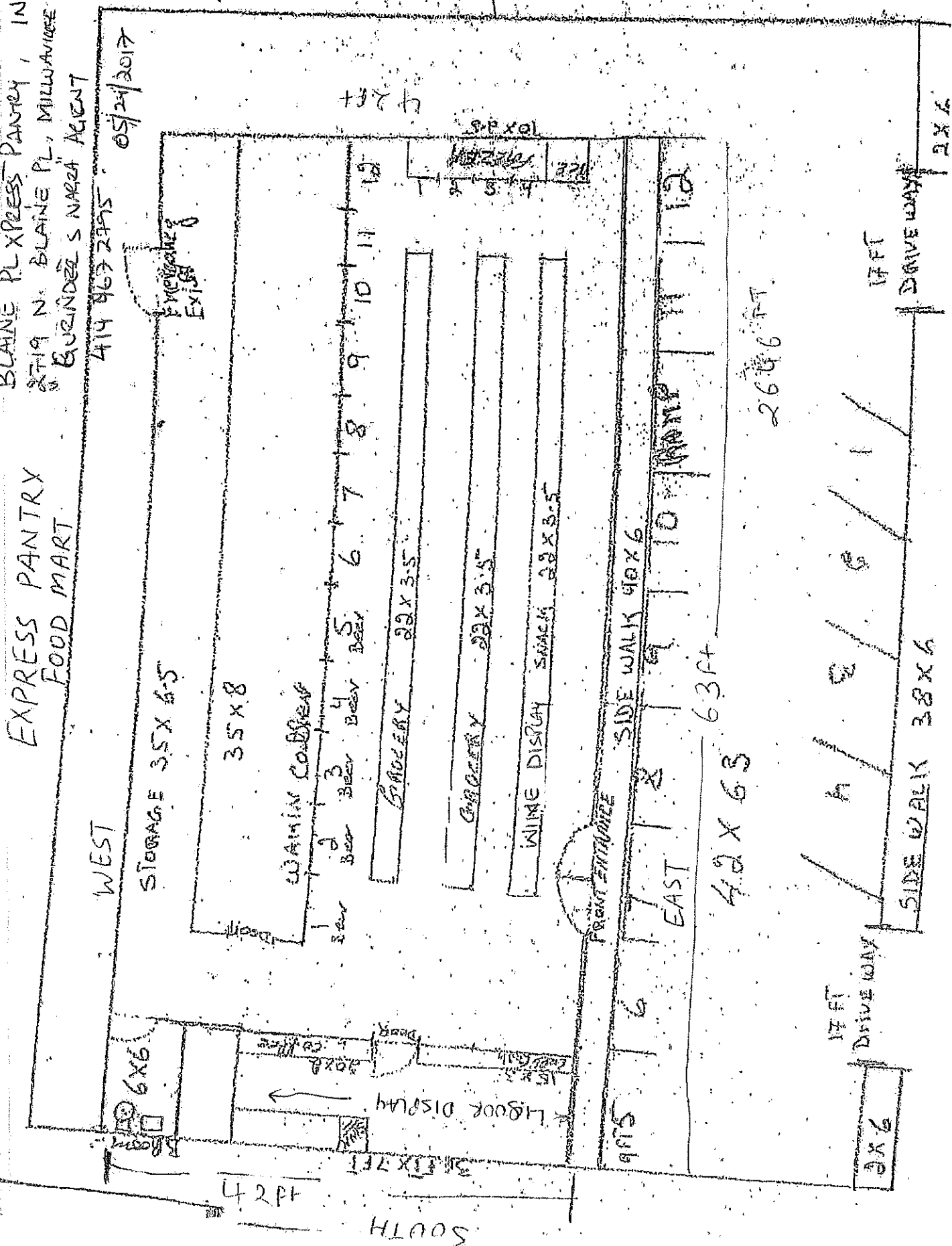

I could not attend the hearing scheduled for today, May 31 at 9:30am because of employment schedule issue. However, I strongly oppose the renewal of Mr. Crossley's application to continue the tattoo and body piercing business to my home,
The reasons are:

1. Since the opening of the tattoo and body piercing store, I've been having problems with his customers trespassing my private parking lot. I have no-parking signs in several visible locations. I've called City parking enforcement office several times to have these people ticketed and towed but by the time the officer arrive, which is any where between 30 minutes to one hour, the people already left. They either block the entrance to my private parking lot or park in it as if they own the property. I've spoken to the customers asking the customers to move their vehicle and pointing to the signs, they've threaten, ignore, and treated me with indifference.
2. This business brings people who have no respect for people, property, or rules. They throw trash all over the place. Some customers smoke marijuana and loiter in front of the store and my home until as late as 11pm with loud music and talking, especially during summer and fall months. They make inappropriate remarks and gestures towards my girls. We are afraid to go outside because of these types of people.

Please consider my written testimony and do not renew the license application for Mr. Crossley's tattoo and body piercing business.

Undercover police officers entered the establishment and requested to purchase single cigarettes from an employee that was behind a partially enclosed counter. The undercover officer purchased two Newport brand cigarettes, which were fifty cents apiece. Another UC entered and approached the same store employee and requested to purchase synthetic marijuana. The employee advised the UC that it would be \$15.00 for his request. The UC purchased a package with the brand name "Wolfpack" on the front. Uniformed officers, as well as agents from the Department of Revenue, entered the business and conducted a license premise check. Vliet St. An employee of the tattoo shop, Kenny WINTERS (m/b, 01-23-92), (#414-501-9852) called 911 and reported a group of males had entered the tattoo shop with firearms and were attempting to rob and/or kidnap him.

Upon our arrival, we located the caller/employee WINTERS, his relative, Lure WEBB (m/b, 01-17-96) coming from the rear of the business located at 3716 W. Vliet St. H&H tattoo is connected to Hustlin Handz Signs (3714 W. Vliet St.) by a rear room. Upon checking Hustlin Handz Signs, an employee Edward PACKER (m/b, 11-25-93) #414-690-1487) and two customers, Justice KING (m/b, 07-02-1999) and Octavius BOLTON (m/b, 10-28-92) were located in a bathroom. Also located in bathroom were two handguns.

In the back room, connecting 3714 and 3716 W. Vliet St., in plain view, a clear plastic bag, containing a green leafy substance, suspected marijuana was located. Also observed were three (3) glass pipes with marijuana residue inside. The tattoo shop and rear room had a strong odor of burnt marijuana. P.O. DEL MORAL tested the green leafy substance, which tested positive for THC, marijuana, 0.36 grams. The marijuana was placed on MPD inventory #17002632. The glass pipes were placed on MPD inventory #17002629.

I spoke with the caller, WINTERS who stated he was tattooing KING when three (3) black males walked in the business. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing black full face ski masks. WINTERS stated all three (3) were wearing all black clothing. WINTERS stated one subject was armed with a silver/black semi automatic pistol. WINTERS stated the second subject was armed with a semi-automatic rifle. WINTERS stated the first male stated to him something similar to "Hey Kenny, let's talk outside". WINTERS stated he was frightened and did not know what the subjects wanted, so he and WEBB ran to the rear of the business and out the back door. WINTERS stated the subjects ran out the front door.



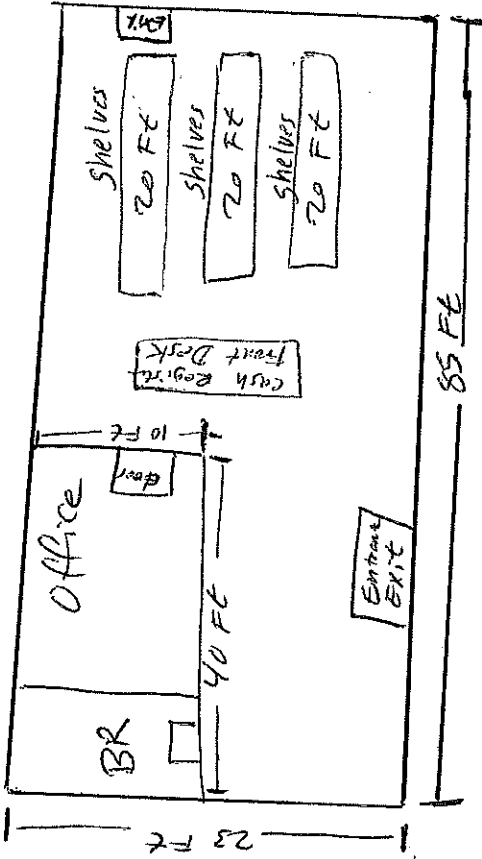

This report is written by Police Officer KUKOWSKI, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/24/17, a meeting was held to discuss specific issues related to drug activity that was taking place in and around the McDonalds at 920 W North Avenue. Issues that were addressed were the building under construction, lighting, signage and parking. Security issues such as physical security patrol as well as a security system. A manager also reported to MPD that there was an issue where someone had the bathrooms blocked off in the restaurant while they were "bagging their drugs". The owner of the restaurant indicated that he would consider putting electronic locks on the bathroom doors to combat this issue. The location is still being monitored by MPD for nuisance related activities.

2. On 02/21/17 at 1 pm, Milwaukee police attempted to conduct a CPTED at 920 W North Avenue. Officers were to meet a store manager, Candice, who was there, but refused to acknowledge police. Officers attempted to speak with another manager, Catina McCoy, however she too refused to speak with police so the survey was completed without management present for it. 16 cameras were observed with 2 not in working order. No loitering or soliciting signs were observed and suggestions for better exterior lighting in the parking lot were made.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Darcie Trunkel assigned to District Three, Day Shift.

ADA Catelin Ringersma sent out a DA/Nuisance letter on 12/8/16. CPUC Gutter was able to make contact w/Steve Johnson (GM-MacPyles) to set up face-to-face meeting at D3. This meeting was held on 1/24/17. Owner (Robert Pyles), GM (Steve Johnson) and the Store Manager were all present at this meeting.

During the meeting, the owner, Robert Pyles, was asked about specific issues (related to drug activity) that were taking place in and or around his business. Initially, he denied any knowledge of any illegal activity. However, he later stated that he know what was going on but didn't know exactly what to do about the problems.

Issues addressed and suggestions:

- The building is currently under construction.
- Due to the construction, there are noticeable issues with lighting, signage and parking. MPD suggested that a CPTED be completed to assist with those issues. Some suggestions included trimming trees and adding additional and brighter lighting. CPTED information was provided to the owner and the general manager.
- Security is a concern: physical security patrol as well as a security system. There are no patrol and the current security system only maintains footage for approximately 30 days. The owner stated that he often has security patrols in the spring and summer months (usually beginning in March) from 4pm-10pm. MPD suggested that security be brought back as soon as possible and that he partner with other businesses to contract security companies.
- The manager informed MPD that there was an issue where someone had the bathrooms blocked off in the restaurant while they were "bagging their drugs." The owner indicated that he would consider putting electronic locks on the bathroom doors (he has utilized this method at some of his other locations) to combat this issue.
- MPD stressed the importance of CALLS FOR SERVICE. For every known instance of drug activity, loitering and any other issue, MPD must be called. Contact guides were also provided to all of the parties from McDonald's.

The suggestions from MPD were to have a CPTED completed, to add security and to CALL the police when issues arise.

This location is still being monitored by MPD for nuisance related activities.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is submitted by PO Lyndsey PETERS assigned to District Three, Modified Early Shift. On 2/21/17, at 1pm, I conducted a CPTED (Crime Prevention by Environmental Design) Survey at 920 W North Ave (McDonald's). We were supposed to meet with Candice (one of the store managers) who was there, but too busy to acknowledge our presence. I attempted to speak with another manager, Catina MCCOY, However, she held her index finger up to me implying I needed to hold on a bit. Twenty five minutes later, she still hadn't come out to speak with us. I ended up conducting the survey without her being present for it. After I did so, I walked behind the counter to get her attention. I asked if we could view their security cameras. She took me to the office in the back where they had the surveillance system. There were 16 cameras in total, however, two were currently not working. She couldn't tell me how long they had been broken for or when they would be fixed. I noticed there were NO surveillance cameras covering the parking lot, which is a big problem, considering the majority of the issues occurring on this premise are in the parking lot. I gave her a current contact guide and I asked her to fill out a standing complaint form after explaining to her the purpose of that. She was reluctant to write her personal information on the form, however, she did provide her name and work number. The business appeared clean, the windows were large and you could easily see in and out. I observed 19 lights on surrounding the exterior and the lighting was good on the interior. They could definitely use better lighting on the exterior. They did have three "No Loitering" signs posted and two "No soliciting" signs. The suggestions I have are to upgrade the lighting in the parking lot, put more surveillance cameras up to make sure they cover the entire parking lot and make sure they are monitoring the parking lot for suspicious activity.
