You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on Tuesday, April 22, 2025, commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider the renewal with a 10 (ten) day suspension of the Class B Tavern, Extended Hours Establishments, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses for the premises located at 551 W Historic Mitchell St. ("Taqueria El Toro LLC").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee, which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation, recommending the renewal with a 10 (ten) day suspension of the Class B Tavern, Extended Hours Establishments, Public Entertainment Premises and Food Dealer licenses based upon the preponderance of the evidence in the police report and licensee testimony that demonstrates the operation results in a threat to the health, safety, or welfare of the public.
