Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Brian Burch. The claim is in the amount of \$495.00 for 4.50 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. A criminal investigation was initiated against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed, but they were ultimately not charged.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officer has retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter. Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent him, and as he was performing the duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved a juvenile arrest for curfew violation.

The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officer initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When he requested counsel, IAD compelled PO Burch to give a statement concerning the incident after issuing a PI-21. Later, the MPD did not bring criminal charges against the officer. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

On Tuesday, March 18, 2003, I Det. Michele HARRISON along with Detective Charles SHEPARD JR. conducted follow-up relative to this investigation. The follow up was to locate Steven STEWART to show him a photo array in attempt to identify the police officer involved in this incident.

We responded to 503 W. North Ave. and met with Steven STEWART. He indicated he could identify the officer who kicked the chair beneath him. I Det. HARRISON did provide STEWART with a photo Array consisting of payroll numbers 67365, 59421, 70052, 67331, 66220, 70343.

Steven STEWART did view the above array at 3:44 p.m. STEWART was unable to pick any of the officers out in the photo array.

Based on this investigation and the victim was unable to pick out an officer, this assignment will be closed as an internal investigation as it can not be substantiated. However, it will remain open as a complaint.

Officer BELL stated that him and Police Officer #5 valked the juveniles into the booking area, and they were handcuffed to the railing to make sure there was no contact with any adults.

Officer BELL stated that Officer BURCH stayed with the juveniles, and he went to advise the Acting Lieutenant, who was Sergeant FIDLER about their arrest. Officer BELL stated that he could not add any further information regarding Battery or Physical Abuse of a Child complaint, because he punched out at 12:17 A.M. He stated his partner booked the juveniles and was not aware of any type of Battery complaint. Officer BELL did indicate at no time was there any type of physical confrontations between him and his partner while the juveniles were being placed in custody.

This interview was then terminated.
