Dear Mr. Wazir and Vivek Vasudeva:

Our office has received your complaint letter, dated May 17, 2012, in regards to the Home Improvement Contractor license of Accent Construction & Remodeling, LLC located at 3209 W. Layton Ave. ("Accent Construction & Remodeling"). A copy of your complaint was forwarded to the City Attorney's Office for review.

This review determined that your revocation request was insufficient. Per s. 95-14-9-e of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances, workmanship is a prohibited factor in licensing determinations and is properly vetted in a civil action in small claims or circuit court. The Department of Neighborhood Services did not confirm outstanding code compliance orders or convictions relative to the home improvement contractor.

If you would like to appear and offer evidence at the next license renewal hearing of Accent Construction & Remodeling, LLC, you may file additional documents to the office of the Licenses Division. Your complaint regarding this licensee has been forwarded to the Licenses Division. In addition, you may seek civil action in small claims or circuit court.
