- Re: Report of the Renewal Application of Faisal Hussain for a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Faisal Hussain (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expires at midnight, October 31, 2018.
- 2. An application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk.
- 3. On September 24, 2018, the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee, pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes, of a police report that could form the basis for suspension or non-renewal of the license and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the police report on October 3, 2018 at approximately 9:30 a.m. in Room 301-B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the licensee did appear with an interpreter, Shazad Ali.
- 4. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
 - A. Notice was sent to Faisal Hussain at 4267 South 26th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53221, along with a copy of the police report on September 24, 2018 in an envelope which was sent by U.S. first-class prepaid mail in an envelope bearing the return address of the License Division, 200 East Wells Street, Room 105, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. The address of 4267 South 26th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53221 was the address given by the applicant on his renewal application. The licensee appeared at the hearing and the envelope containing the notice and police report was not returned to the License Division by the U.S. Postal Service.



B. The Wisconsin Department of Transportation suspended the applicant's driver's license for the following:

07/02/16	Accident – Property Damage
04/26/17-07/13/17	Guilty speeding excess
07/14/17	15 days for speeding excess – 20 or more over
10/21/17-12/08/17	Guilty defective speedometer
10/21/17-12/08/17	Guilty license not on person
10/23/17	Reinstated OPR
03/04/18-04/02/18	Guilty restrictions on parking and stopping in Construction
	Zone

C. The licensee stated he did not look at the speedometer when he was speeding and was in his own vehicle. He added that he does not currently drive, but he wants to start driving a taxi.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and § 349.24, Wisconsin Statutes.
- Based upon the above facts found, the Committee concludes that the licensee, Faisal Hussain, has not met the criteria of Chapter 100 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances or § 349.24 of the Wisconsin Statutes to allow renewal of his Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License based upon the police report.
- 3. In order to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Milwaukee, it is the recommendation of the Public Works Committee that the full Common Council of the City of Milwaukee should exercise its judgment to not renew the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License held by Faisal Hussain based upon the police report.

RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee recommends by a vote of **four (4) ayes, zero (0) noes and one (1) excused** that the Public Passenger Vehicle Driver License of Faisal Hussain not be renewed based upon the police report.

Said nonrenewal begins November 1, 2018.
