Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; thef; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

 On 02/24/2016 officers went to State Beer Liquor, 2537 W. State St for a licensed premises check. The officer asked to see the licenses and was told they were not on the premise. The applicant was cited for Display of License-Posting Required.

On 02/16/2017 officers responded to a strong armed robbery call at State Beer Liquor, 2537 W. State St. The victim, who was a customer of the store, stated an unknown male pushed him and took his money. The clerk observed the incident and was cooperative with the officers. The video of the incident was recovered. Milwaukee Police Department IR# 17-047-0137 filed.

- 3. On 08/25/2017 officers were dispatched to a strong armed robbery at 2537 W. State St. The clerk, Sukhwinder SINGH, stated a frequent customer came in and took three bottles of wine. The officers viewed the surveillance video and identified the subject who is known to them. He was stopped the next day and cited for this incident.
- 4. On 11/03/2017 officers were dispatched to State Beer and Liquor, 2537 W. State St for a trouble with subject. The applicant was on scene and stated a subject who had been banned was at the store refusing to leave. The subject was identified and cited.
- 5. On 11/05/2017 officers were dispatched to a fight inside State Beer and Liquor, 2537 W. State St. The officers spoke with the manager, Bhupinder SINGH, who stated a subject who had been banned was in the store causing a disturbance. He did not wish to press charges, he just wanted the subject to not return.
- 6. On 11/14/2017 officers were advised by the clerk at State Beer and Liquor of a theft that occurred on 11/13/2017. The clerk, Bhupinder SINGH, stated a subject took a bottle of liquor without paying for it. The officers viewed the video and identified the subject who was known to them. A report was filed and presented to the District Attorney's office.
- 7. On 11/26/2017 at 4:26am officers were dispatched to an entry to business complaint at 2537 W. State St. The investigation revealed an entry did occur and bottles of alcohol were taken. The applicant was on scene and cooperative. He did not know how to view the surveillance at the store monitors but showed the officer on his phone.
- 8. On 12/17/2017 at 4:19am officers were dispatched to an entry complaint at 2537 W. State St. The officer cleared the building but did not locate any suspects. The applicant arrived and showed the officer video surveillance on his phone. The video showed a subject entering through a side door and removing property. The subject returns two more times and removes addition property. The applicant did not know how to copy the footage but stated he would attempt to email it.
- 9. On 02/14/2018 officers observed a subject loitering in front of the store at 2537 W. State St. The subject walked off when he saw police. The clerk confirmed the subject had been loitering outside for 30 minutes and requested the officer ask him to not loiter in front of the store. The subject was located and arrested for a violation of probation.

- 10. On 07/10/2019 at 11:30pm officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint at 732 N. 25th St. The battery occurred at 2537 W. State St at 8:50pm. The victim stated known actor came into the business and attempted to walk out with 4 bottles of wine. The victim stopped the subject, who then struck the victim in the head with a bottle, causing a severe laceration to his head. The victim provided video of the incident.
- 11. On 07/23/2019 at 12:34am officers were dispatched to an Entry at RK Liquor, 2537 W. State St. The applicant was on scene and stated someone had entered the building through the back door. He stated nothing appeared to be missing and he did not want a report filed.

- 12. On 11/05/2019 at 6:44pm officers were flagged down for an Armed Robbery at RK Liquor, 2537 W. State St. The suspect was loitering in the store and waited until the clerk was entering the cash register area. The suspect produced a firearm and demanded money. After obtaining the money the suspect fled the scene. The employees were cooperative with officers.
- 13.On 03/28/2020 at 10:56am officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at 2537 W. State St. The clerk stated he observed a window broken and 15 cartons of cigarettes missing from the second floor store room. The cameras were disabled during this incident.
- 14. On 03/30/2020 at 3:51am officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at RK Liquor, 2537 W. State St. when the officers arrived they spoke with the applicant who stated two windows broken on the upper were broken. The officers cleared the business and determined no entry was gained.

- 15. On 10/18/21 at 7:19pm, officers were dispatched to 2537 W State St., for an Overdose. Officers were met by MFD who were with the victim and had revived the victim with Narcan. The victim admitted to ingesting heroin and was conveyed to the hospital for further treatment. The employee was interviewed and stated the subject came into the store and didn't look well. The employee stated he assisted the subject outside while a customer called 911.
- 16. On 02/07/23 at 4:34p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Drug Dealing at 2537 W. State St. The caller/employee stated they asked a subject to leave the store, however, the subject refused. The officers asked the subject to leave, to which they complied. The employee was cooperative with the officers.

- 17. On 02/07/23 at 8:59p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 2537 W. State St. Officers were advised this was the same subject from Item #16m however, this time the subject made threats to wait outside the store upon closing. The subject was gone on officer's arrival, and the officers waited outside with the employees as they left for the night.
- 18. On 06/29/23, Milwaukee Police were assigned to work Wisconsin WINS, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. At 4:40p.m., a youth entered 2537 W State St and purchased tobacco from the cashier, without checking or asking for ID. On entrance the cashier that sold was avoiding the officer, however, the officer was able to identify the cashier by another employee. A citation was issued to the agent.

This report is written by P.O. Jacob BACZEK, assigned to District 3, Day Shift.

On Monday, February 17th, 2025, at 10:32 a.m., squad 3120 (P.O. Blaine GRABOWSKI and myself) were dispatched to the RK Liquor Store located at 2537 West State Street in the City and County of Milwaukee. Upon arrival, I spoke to Hassani A. LUCAS (B/F 10-19-99) who stated that she works for the Near Westside Partners, an organization that helps local businesses. LUCAS stated she was notified by the owner of the RK Liquor store (2537 West State St) that a known citizen, Norvella P. TURNER (B/F 09-03-72) entered the store and began to tear up the store. LUCAS stated she arrived at the store several minutes later, and observed that the store was a complete mess, with merchandise ripped off of the shelves and thrown all over the floor. LUCAS stated that TURNER comes in and does this everyday at the store, but today was this worst she had seen. Upon my arrival, the store had already been cleaned up. LUCAS was provided a link to Evidence.com and uploaded the photos of the mess that TURNER created as well as the store merchandise that was damaged.

I interviewed the store clerk, Jatinder SINGH (W/M 10-10-02), who stated that TURNER entered the store and began talking and yelling. SINGH stated that he could not make sense of what TURNER was saying, and that she is known to do drugs. SINGH stated that TURNER then began to swing a cane, which TURNER left at the scene. SINGH stated TURNER began knocking the merchandise off of the shelves with the cane, and when he tried to stop her she swung the cane at him and threatened him.

I watched the video on SINGH's phone, which displays TURNER entering the store and almost immediately begin to swing the cane and begin knocking items off of the shelves and damaging merchandise. SINGH is then observed coming from behind the counter, at which time TURNER is observed raising and swinging the cane in SINGH's direction. TURNER is then observed leaving the store. SINGH was provided a link to Evidence.com to upload the video of the incident for exact times from the start of the incident to the end of the incident.

I placed the cane that was recovered from the scene on MPD inventory# 25004123 as evidence. SINGH was issued a PV-17. P.O. GRABOWSKI and myself then checked the area for TURNER, however she was not located.

The business had valid licenses thru 07-21-2025.

I spoke to the Agent of the store, Davinder SINGH (W/M 02-02-68) who stated he originally did not call the emergency or non emergency line, but did contact the District 3 police station who instructed him to call. SINGH stated that this is an ongoing problem with TURNER and that she comes in and tears up the store almost everyday however this was the first time that they have called the police.

Upon our arrival I observed a brick building with the above listed address and name printed in front of the residence. I then observed male subject later identified as SINGH, SUKHWINDER S (M/W 05/02/1960) inside of the business with multiple citizens inside of the store. I observed all working cameras inside of the residence and updated license posted inside of the business. I did not observe any license violations

SINGH, SUKHWINDER INTERVIEW:

I then spoke with SINGH, SUKHWINDER who stated on 05/02/2025 at approximately 8:00AM female subject later identified as TURNER, NORVELLA PATRICE (F/B 09/03/1972) entered the above listed address and business. SINGH, SUKHWINDER stated TURNER entered the business grabbed two bottles of Four Loco and gave the employees one dollar and exited the business. SINGH, SUKHWINDER stated shortly before officers arrived on scene 05/02/2025 at approximately 3:12PM he observed TURNER in front of the above listed residence. SINGH, SUKHWINDER stated TURNED approached him without making any statements but fled from the scene southbound from the 2600 block West State street prior to officers arriving on scene. It should be noted SINGH, SUKHWINDER is the owner of the RK Liquor who has an active no contact order against TURNER which states TURNER can not have any contact with RK Liquor.

SINGH, HORJIT INTERVIEW:

I then spoke with SINGH, HORJIT (M/W 01/26/199 who informed me that he observed TURNER enter the business on 05/02/2025 at approximately 8:45AM. SINGH, HORJIT showed me video footage which depicted TURNER entering the business at 8:45AM purchasing the items and exiting the business on foot. TURNER is described as (Black female, slim build, short hair, last seen wearing a grey coat, light colored leggings, and pink shoes).

A records check revealed TURNER has a open case for disorderly conduct which also states she can have no contact with RK Liquor(Case number 2025CM000602)

PO HUDSON and I checked the area for TURNER but was unsuccessful locating. It should be noted SINGH, SUKHWINDER stated TURNER has been a constant issue for the business and arrested multiple times with no results leading to her being prosecuted. SINGH, SUKHWINDER stated TURNER constantly returns to the business.

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
