This is to notify you that on April 19, 2005 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application as agent for BRC Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a "219" for a Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement (Cabaret/Nite Club) license for the premises at 219 South 2nd Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("219") be approved with a ten (10) day suspension. Following consideration of the report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted the Committee's recommendation by a vote of fourteen (14) ayes, zero (0) noes and one (1) excused to renew the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement (Cabaret/Nite Club) license for the licensed premises at 219 South 2nd Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("219") with a ten (10) day suspension.

Said suspension is to be in effect between midnight, May 18, 2005 through midnight, May 28, 2005.
