There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.



Upon arrival I parked my marked squad approximately one half block away from the bar (Urban Bay View) and could hear loud talking and yelling coming from the patio of the bar which faces to the west from the premise. Officers then entered the bar and made contact with the bartender on duty, Marta Alcantar (w/f,05-17-88) and explained the situation. Alcantar stated that she has been monitoring the patio because she is aware of the neighbor calling in noise complaints. Alcantar stated that she would go out to the patio and have the people come inside the bar. While speaking with Alcantar we conducted a Tavern Check and ensured the bar licenses were valid, which they were. I then asked Alcantar for her Class D Operator's Liquor License, Alcantar stated that she just came home from the Dells and was not sure if she had it with her, Alcantar did say that she had a license and it was valid. I went out to the squad car and went onto LIRA (Licensing Information Reporting and Administration System) via my vehicles MDC to confirm she had a valid license. A check of LIRA revealed that that Alcantar had an application date of 5-04-2018 but had pending warrants/fine satisfaction that made her license not valid. I confirmed this information with LIU and the following morning had confirmation that Alcantar did not have a valid Class D license.

On Friday, August 31, 2018 at 6:55pm I contacted the licensee, Paul U. Jonas (w/m, 01-28-67) and informed him of the noise complaint and that Alcantar did not have a valid Class D license. Jonas stated that he has been trying to resolve the issues with the neighbor and that he will make sure Alcantar gets her Class D license taken care of. Jonas stated that Alcantar was supposed to work tonight but would have another licensed there with her. I also informed Jonas that he would be receiving a citation in the mail for not having a Class D licensed operator working and that a License Premise Report would be filed.

I then contacted Alcantar and informed her that she does not have a valid Class D license and that she would be receiving a citation in the mail. Alcantar stated that she would resolve the situation on Tuesday but believes that she faxed proof of payment into LIU.

On Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at 11:12pm, I along with P.O. James Dauer were dispatched to a noise nuisance at 2301 S. Logan Ave (Urban Bay View).

Upon arrival I spoke to the caller, Dennis R. Kukla (w/m, 07-20-52) who lives next door to the west of Urban Bay View and between Kukla's house and the bar is a patio. Kukla stated that tonight at approximately 10:50pm there were at least three patrons on the patio, two of them had their dogs with them. Kukla stated that the dogs began barking at something and then the dog owners began yelling loudly at the dogs, causing a disturbance. When I arrived on scene I did observe 3-5 patrons on the outside patio to the west of the bar, I did not hear any yelling or dog barking when I arrived on scene.

I then went inside the bar I spoke to the bartender, Karla E. Larock (w/f, 03-14-89) who stated that she has been trying to monitor the noise on the patio because she knows the issues that the owner/licensee, Paul U. Jonas (w/m, 01-28-670) has been having with the neighbor (Kukla). I informed Larock about the yelling at which time she told the patrons to leave from the west side patio and go to the one that is on the east side of the bar. I told Larock that I would be filing this license premise report and I would notify Jonas. Larock then informed me that Jonas is on vacation for two weeks. This is an ongoing issue between Kukla and Jonas.

I then notified Jonas on 09-12-18 at 12:23am by leaving a voicemail at 414-588-7366 and informed him of the incident and that a license premise report would be filed.
