Dear Council Members,

While still under the name of Meto Magikist at 1844 W. Fond Du Lac Ave. Milwaukee. The owner Al Reichle requested the city inspectors to do an inspection prior to the sale of the premises. Upon completion the inspectors found plumbing issues and there was at that time no emergency exit door.

At which time he was instructed on the size of the door, what kind of material it was to be made from, no door handle and just a push bar for quick exits. There was no mention of the distance that the door would swing or anything else.

Before the sale of Metro Magikist to Andes Cleaning Service, Mr. Reichle had an emergency door installed (with a push bar) at the northeast corner of the building. The only place that was acceptable to Mr. Robinson (the building inspector).

Now after taking up occupancy (as Andes-Magikist) we are told the door only can swing into the alley 12 inches.

Since this door is an emergency door and not used for municipal purposes, or on a daily basis and to replace or move the door would be an unnecessary cost since the door is already in place. I am asking you to grant us permission to leave the door as is.
