The claim is in the amount of \$951.49 including \$5.49 in disbursements for 8.60 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Conduct Disturbance. Additionally, Officers CHU and SCANLAN contacted squad 2P, Sgt. Richard STEIN, to advise him of their off duty arrest.

Also interviewed in regards to this offense, by Det. Hattie NICHOLS, was a security person working at Wilbur's Tavern, a Robert B. KAMINSKI (W/M, DOB 12-20-76). Mr. KAMINSKI indicated he was working in the early morning hours of June 16, 2000, when Daniel BLOOM entered the tavern in an extremely intoxicated condition. When Mr. KAMINSKI told him it was closing time and he would not be served, this intoxicated white male, Daniel BLOOM, began to struggle with him and Officers Christopher CHU and Aaron SCANLAN approached the intoxicated white male and identified themselves as police officers and displayed their badges. Mr. KAMINSKI further stated that the subject Daniel BLOOM then swung at the officer wearing glasses (P.O. CHU) and the two officers then took the subject outside.

CONCLUSION:

Based on the totality of this investigation, this complaint will be cleared as baseless. Although Mr. BLOOM did have a small bruise below his right eye, there is nothing to indicate that this injury occurred as a result of his arrest by City of Milwaukee police officers on June 16, 2000. It should be noted that during the interview with Mr. BLOOM, he was still extremely intoxicated, even though it was eight hours after this incident occurred. Due to all of the aforementioned reasons, there is not any evidence to sustain a charge of battery against either Officer Christopher CHU, Officer Aaron SCANLAN or any other person for Mr. BLOOM'S injuries on June 16, 2000.
