There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 01/24/2005 at 21:30 officers made a lawful inspection of the licensed premises at 1460 s Muskego. Officers found a exit door locked. The applicant told officers the building inspector and his alderman told him the door could be locked.

2. On 12/16/06 at 1:50 am, Milwaukee Police conduct a tavern check at 1460 W Muskego along with officers from the Intelligence Division and the Warrant Squad. Officers found the licensee, Gustavo Guizar, highly intoxicated and when advised the officers were there to conduct a tavern check, Guizar became argumentative with police. Guizar demanded that the police leave. While conducting the tavern check, officers located a loaded semi-auto pistol in a drawer under the cash register. Guizar stated to the police that the gun was his. Officers confiscated the firearm and placed it on inventory for safekeeping due to Guizar intoxication.

3. On 08/27/07 at 1:52 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1460 S Muskego for a Fight complaint. Officers spoke to Gustavo Guizar who stated that at about 1:00 am, he observed 5 subjects fighting inside the tavern and that it continued outside. Guizar stated the reason why he didn't call police right away because a patron who was hurt stated he was ok and Guizar believed police weren't needed. Officers issued Guizar a citation for Disorderly Premises Prohibited.

4. On 11/12/07 at 1:27 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1460 W Muskego for an Entry complaint. Investigation found that someone forced the front door open and removed \$500.00 dollars from two registers. A report was filed.

5. On 02/18/12 at 2:15 am, an altercation happened inside The Tequilla Club between two groups of people. An officer spoke to Gustavo Guizar who stated he and his security escorted one group out the side door of the bar and then escorted the second group out the front door. A short time later a physical fight between the two groups occurred on the sidewalk in front of the club resulting in two battery victims. One victim was struck in the head with a bottle and needed 5 stitches to close the wound. The other victim was struck with a stick in the head and also required 5 stitches to close the wound. A charge of battery was issued to one suspect, which was no processed by the District Attorney.

6. On 11/03/12 at 3:38 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1557 S 15th Street for a Property Damage complaint. Investigation found a patron entered the bar at 1460 S Muskego but was refused service due to his intoxication and was asked to leave. The patron then threatened to mess up one of the employee's car and upon leaving, broke the window to the employee's auto by throwing a brick at it.

- 11. On 08/21/17 at 1:06 am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1460 S. Muskego Avenue (Tequila Night Club) for a threat complaint. Upon arrival officers learned from the agent that an intoxicated patron made threats to shoot up the tavern. The agent decided to close the establishment early to prevent the subject from returning. No report was filed.
- 12. On 03/25/18 at 3:23 am, Milwaukee Police investigated a battery that took place at 1460 S. Muskego Avenue (Tequila Night Club). The investigation revealed that an assault happened inside the tavern earlier in the evening between three subjects. When the agent was contacted about the incident, he confirmed that it did happen inside the establishment and he called 911 but there was no police response. A later check by officers revealed that there were no incoming "calls for service" from the agent during the time of the incident. The surveillance system for the tavern was not functioning at the time of the assault and officers observed that the Class B Tavern license for the establishment was not hanging prominently on the wall. The agent was advised about the license and a citation was issued to the battery suspect.

This report is written by PO Benjamin SPITZER, District Two, Late Power.

On Sunday, March 25th, 2018 at 3:23AM while assigned to SQ 2464 (PO ESPITIA and I) were dispatched to 2324 W. Orchard St. for a battery complaint.

The caller, Roxanne R. NOVAK (W/F, 11-29-85), stated she was at the Tequila Night Club, 1460 S. Muskego Av, drinking with another family member. NOVAK stated a known subject, identified as Dayshia K. MCPHERSON (B/F, 11-10-95), physically assaulted her and the DJ for the night club. NOVAK stated MCPHERSON pulled her hair, and punched her several times about the face causing pain. NOVAK stated she wished to prosecute. We responded to MCPHERSON's address, 1458 S. Muskego Av. #2, and spoke with her regarding this incident. MCPHERSON stated she was at the club, but denied the battery. The Tequila Night Club was already closed, and we were initially unable to conduct a tavern check regarding this matter.

On the same date, at 9:26PM, we conducted a tavern check at the Tequila Night Club, regarding this matter. I spoke with the owner, Gustavo GUIZAR (W/M, 08-08-67), who stated he observed the altercation. GUIZAR stated he called the Police, who never responded. GUIZAR showed me his call log on his phone, and I did observe an outgoing call for 9-1-1. A check of our CAD system revealed no calls from GUIZAR regarding this incident on the reported date. I asked GUIZAR to view the cameras and he stated they were currently not operational. I checked the system and was able to confirm the system did not record anything on March 25th. The Class B tavern license was not hanging on the wall, and was in a frame resting behind the tavern. GUIZAR stated it broke off the wall, and I advised him that he needed to hang it again in a location visible to the public.

I issued MCPHERSON a battery citation (CIT#J980XPPTMC) regarding this matter. 3

- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.





- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
