If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Limited parking for persons attending meetings in City Hall is available at reduced rates (5 hour limit) at the Milwaukee Center on the southwest corner of East Kilbourn and North Water Street. Parking tickets must be validated in the first floor information booth in City Hall.

Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. 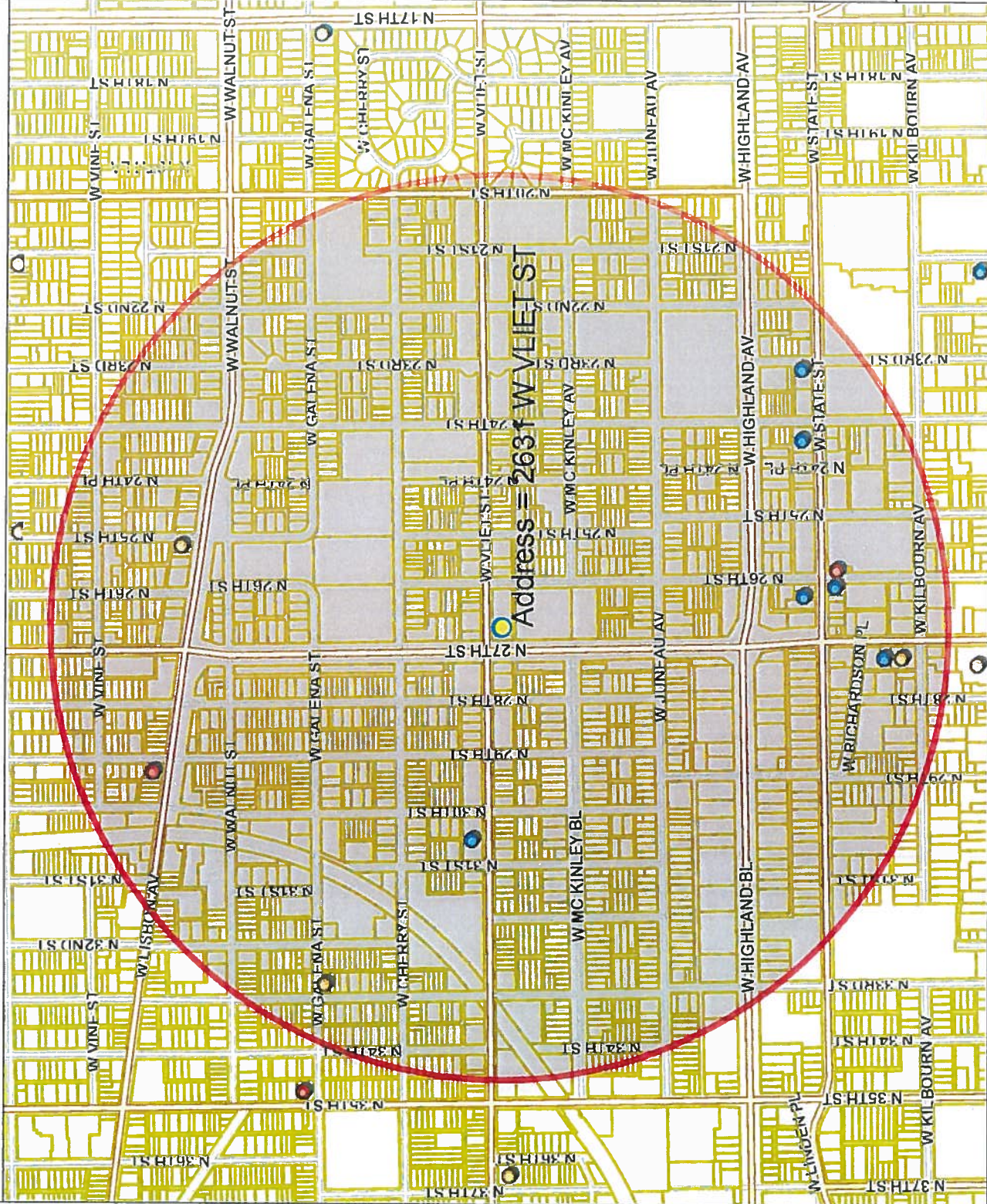

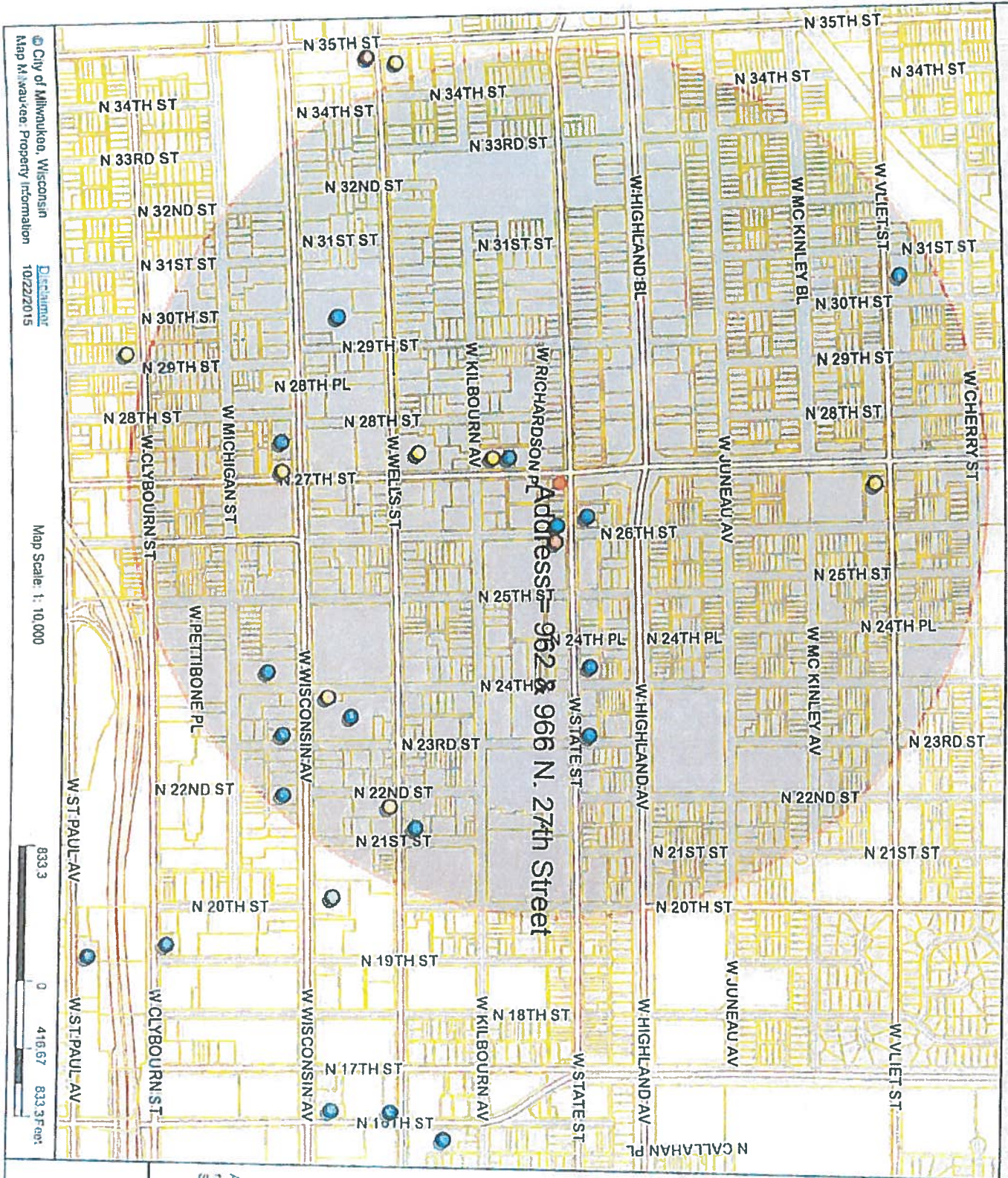

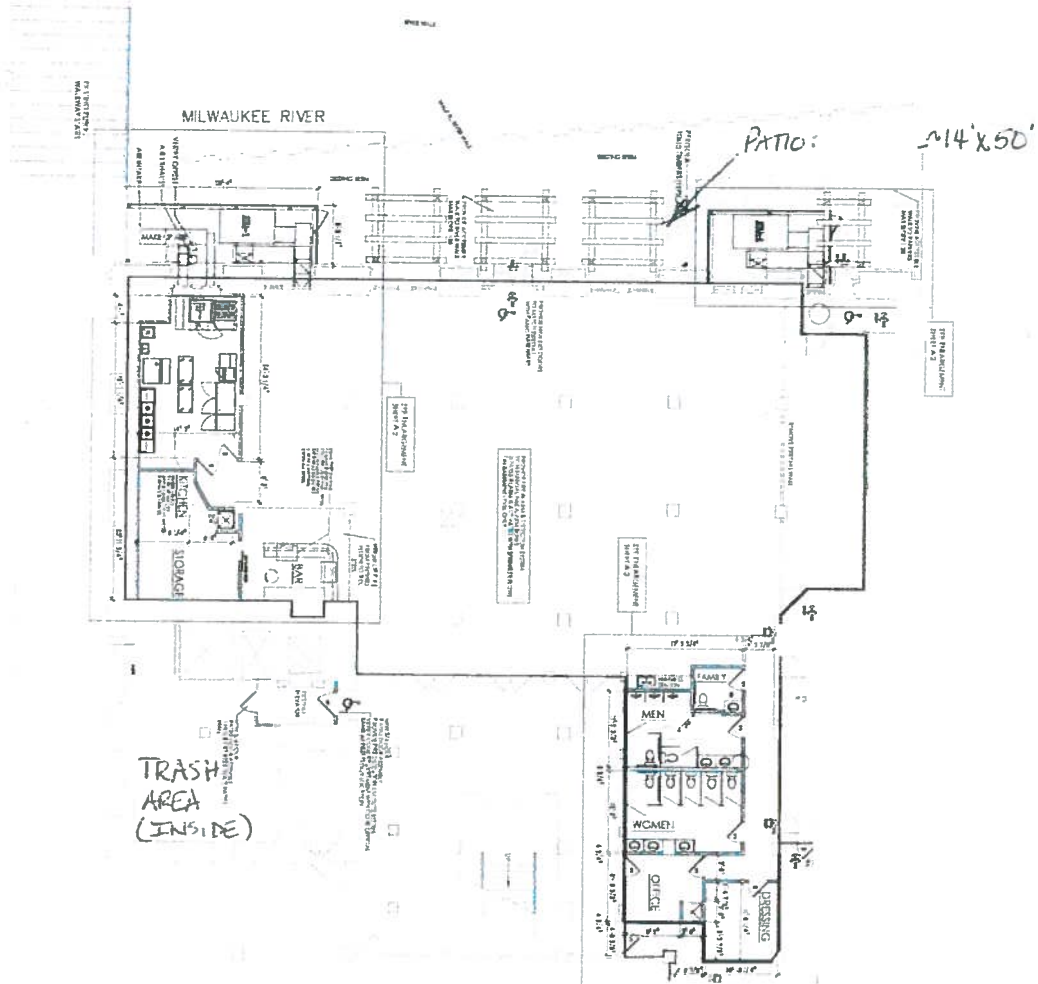

Narrative text

This report is written by Marquette University Police Department (MUPD), Officer Robert Hatch, unit #238, assigned to the night shift.

On Friday, September 16, 2016 at 1933 hours, while working in plain clothes on an alcohol enforcement initiative with my partner, Officer M. Wichgers, unit #227, near the 700 block of W. Wisconsin Avenue, within the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, we observed BRIAN T. CAHILL and MATTEO Z. GRUJIC enter the Westown Market liquor store, located at 700 W. Wisconsin Avenue. Both CAHILL and GRUJIC appeared under the age of 21 and CAHILL was carrying a black backpack, which appeared to be empty. CAHILL and GRUJIC then exited the store after a few minutes and CAHILL'S backpack appeared to be full. Based on my training and experience, underage individuals are known to place alcohol in their backpacks to conceal the alcohol and be able to return to a residence hall without detection from hall staff.

Officer Wichgers and I approached CAHILL and GRUJIC, showed our badges and identified ourselves as Police Officers. We asked CAHILL and GRUJIC for identification and if they were 21 years of age or older. Both subjects stated they were not 21 years old. I asked CAHILL what he had in his backpack and he stated, "Beer." I then asked him to provide his identification and to give me his fraudulent identification if he used one to purchase alcohol. CAHILL and GRUJIC were identified both by driver's license and Marquette University identification cards. CAHILL also handed me a fraudulent identification, showing his date of birth as 03/01/1995. CAHILL's correct date of birth is 10/8/1997.

I then had CAHILL empty his backpack, which contained a 30 pack of Busch Light beer. I had CAHILL and GRUJIC dispose of the alcohol and place the cans on the sidewalk where I later had Officer DeMeuse, unit #240, transport the cans back to the MUPD office, located 749 N. 16th street, where photos were later taken by Officer Wichgers and I, before the cans were disposed of. CAHILL and GRUJIC were advised of potential citations related to underage alcohol possession and false identifications and sent on their way.

On Saturday, September 17, 2016, while filing a field contact report relating to CAHILL and GRUJIC, I found further documentation (refer to FC #478759) written by Officer Wagner, who was also working an alcohol enforcement initiative on 08/27/2016, in which CAHILL was stopped after purchasing alcohol from Westown Market and advised. Due to CAHILL previously being advised, I then issued citations #LR8132KRBR, Adult-Minor/Underage-Misrepresentation of Age and #LR8132KRBS, Adult-Age 17-20 Possess/Consume Alcoholic Beverage to CAHILL.

I made several attempts on both 9/17/2016 and 9/18/2016 to deliver the citations to CAHILL in person, but could not make contact with him. The citations were then mailed on 9/19/2016 to CAHILL's on campus address, 1530 W. Wisconsin Avenue, #1112.

A copy of CAHILL's fraudulent identification is found in the digital media section of this report. The actual identification is inventoried under #16-0677.

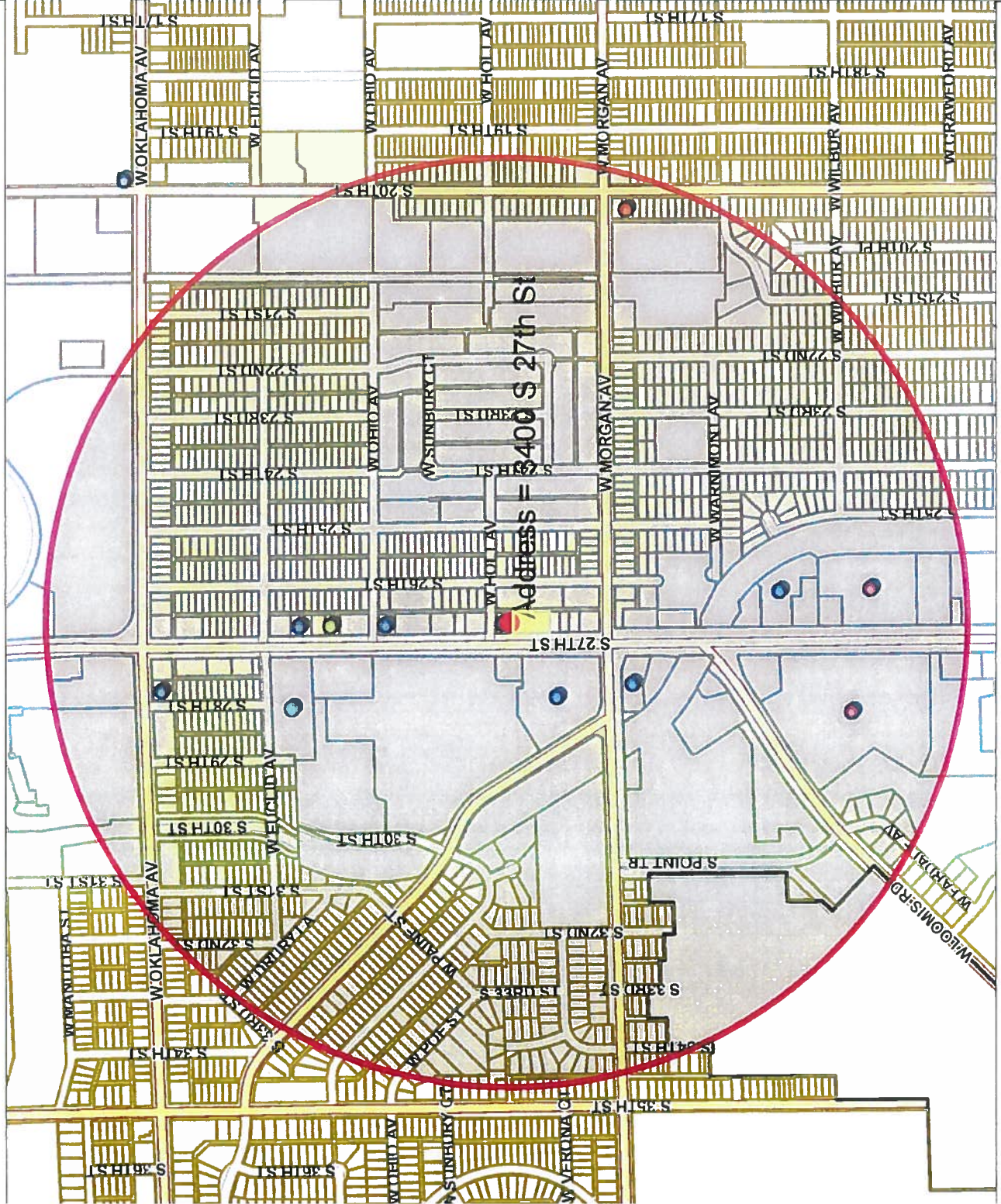
