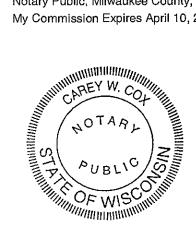

Notice is hereby given that an ordinance that was introduced at the January 15, 2008 meeting of the Milwaukee Comman Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Two-Family Residential to a Detailed Planned Development known as Saint Rita's Apartments, lacated on the North Side of East Pleasant Street and East of North Van Buren Street for residential, commercial, parking and park/plazo uses, in the 3rd Aldermanic District.

The Mayor and Common Cauncil of the City of Milwaukee ("Cammon Council"), do ordain as follows

Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-907(2)(c).0123. (1) In occordance with the provisions of Section 293-907 of the Code relating to the establishment of planned development districts, the Comman Council opproves the subject Detailed Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Common Council File os Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the area described and bounded by the zoning line along the right-of-way of East Pleasant Street, the zoning line along the right-of-way of North Von Buren Street, the zoning line along the right-of-way of North Cass Street, o line 113:36 feet Narth and parollel to the north line of East Pleasant Street, a line 60 feet North and parollel to the narth line of Eost Pleasant Street and a line 190 feet North and parallel to the north line of East Pleasant Street, from Two-Fomily Residential (RT4) to De-toiled Planned Development (DPD).

(3) The requirements set forth in said detailed plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, canstitute the zoning regulations for the orea contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such detailed plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the detailed plan to all canditions and limitations set forth in such detailed plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling, or monaging ony building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be

placed or there exists anything in violo-tion of the terms of this ordinance; or wha shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or ony person, firm, campany or corporation who shall amit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.
