Dear Council Members:


Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Ryan Lemke and Patrick Elm. The claim is in the amount of \$1,155.06, including \$33.06 in disbursements, for 10.20 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

Dear Chief Jones:

I conducted an investigation into the shooting of Almon Madden by Milwaukee police officer Ryan Lemke on August 6, 2000, at the Bridgeport Apartments, 3001 West Silver Spring Drive, Milwaukee.

I concluded that Lemke's shooting of Madden was privileged in self-defense under section 939.48, Stats. Although mistaken, Lemke's belief that Madden was armed was not unreasonable under the circumstances. Therefore, no criminal charges will be issued against officer Lemke for shooting Madden.

Thank you for your department's cooperation in the investigation of the shooting.
