This report is written by Police Officer Xavier Benitez, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 08/08/2007, at 9:34am, a Milwaukee Police Department squad was sent to an armed robbery at the Wendy's parking lot 4601 W North Avenue. Upon arrival spoke to the manager who stated as he was walking to his car he was robbed of the night deposit, which is approximately \$2000.00. He stated it was two black males with a gun in a maroon Ford Expedition that fled eastbound through the rear alley.
2. On 05/31/18 at 8:24am a squad was dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue (Wendy's) for a burglary complaint. Squad arrives and concludes a burglary did happen and an incident report was filed (171510029).
3. On 08/20/17 at 4:00pm a Milwaukee Police squad, while on patrol, observed two vehicles and a pedestrian dealing drugs in the parking lot at 4601 W. North Avenue (Wendy's). The officer's stopped the individuals in the parking lot, found drugs and drug packaging material, and they were arrested. An incident number was filed (172320130)

4. On 03/19/2019 officers were dispatched to a property damage at Wendy's, 4601 W. North Av. The officers spoke with that manager who stated an employee was having a problem with an ex-boyfriend. The employee stated she had an argument with her ex-boyfriend prior to coming to work. When she got to work he pulled up in his car and she closed the business door and locked it. He then kicked the door and left the scene.

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5. On 10/04/20 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4061 W. North Av (Wendy's) for a hold up alarm. Upon arrival officers spoke with an employee who stated that the alarm was activated by mistake, and did not require the police. Officers checked the restaurant and observed that no one was in distress. The employee was not pleased that the police were at the location.

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6. On 09/02/22 at 2:04pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue for a property damage complaint. Investigation revealed that two terminated employees damaged property at the establishment. The manager had surveillance footage of the incident and she was cooperative with the investigation.

7. On 11/06/22 at 6:22pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue for a shots fired complaint. Surveillance footage showed a vehicle parking in the middle of N. 46<sup>th</sup> Street, just south of W. North Avenue. The driver exits the vehicle and walks toward the establishment and at the same time an employee of Wendy's exits the building and walks toward the drive through. The two subjects exchange gunfire, and both leave the scene before police arrival.

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8. On 03/24/23 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue for a theft complaint. Officers spoke to the employee who stated that his phone was taken while he was on his lunch break. Officers reviewed video of the incident, and the phone was taken by two customers of the restaurant, while the employee walked away.

9. On 04/03/23 at 8:32am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue for a damage to property complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that on the previous night a customer became upset over a food order. The customer exited her vehicle and threw a car jack at the business window damaging the window. The manager stated that he would get a working copy of the video for officers at a later date.

10. On 10/22/23 at 11:40pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 4601 W. North Avenue for a sick and injured complaint. Officers spoke with the manager who stated that an employee had a medical emergency. Milwaukee Fire Department was on scene treating the employee. The manager stated that employee was working and then he just fell to the floor. The employee was conveyed to the hospital for medical evaluation.

On Monday, April 03, 2023, at 8:32 a.m. my partner P.O. Lafayette EMMONS and I were dispatched to investigate a damage to property complaint at Wendy's Restaurant at 4601 W. North Ave. in the city and county of Milwaukee.

Upon our arrival, I spoke to the caller Theo C. HARDWICK (B/M 02-09-89) who is the assistant store manager at Wendy's. HARDWICK stated, on Sunday, April 02, 2023, at approximately 11:30 p.m. while working the drive thru window a female was upset that Wendy's was out of chili. HARDWICK stated, an argument began and the customer became very irate. HARDWICK stated, the customer made threats to harm him with a gun. HARDWICK stated the customer pulled around from the drive thru window and opened the trunk of her vehicle. HARDWICK stated, the customer took a black car jack from her trunk and threw it at the Wendy's window on the west side of the building. HARDWICK stated the customer fled in her vehicle in an unknown direction.

HARDWICK described the customer as a black female, 5'05, weighing approximately 120 pounds, slim build, light complexion, with her hair braided in four plats, wearing gray sweatpants and a dark colored t-shirt. HARDWICK stated the customer was operating a white 4dr vehicle with unknown make and model with no license plates.

HARDWICK stated the estimated damage of the window is \$1,900.00. HARDWICK stated, Wendy's are insured by Old Colony Insurance. Sqd. 3193 CSO Angeline White responded to our location and took 9 photos of the broken window at 9:05 a.m.. HARDWICK stated, he wasn't sure how to work their video surveillance cameras and would get the video to me later. I was able to recover the car jack that was used in the property damage and placed it on Milwaukee Police Department Inventory # 23010842. HARDWICK was issued a PV-17.

This case is pending.

This report is written by Benjamin WRIGHT assigned to the Milwaukee Police Department's Third District, Late Power Shift.

On Sunday, October 22, 2023 at 11:40 PM, Squad 3430 (P.O. Richard TOLENTINO and I) was dispatched a Sick and Injured call for service at Wendy's, 4601 W. North Ave., which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Upon our arrival, Squad 3430 observed Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) Engine 32 and Med 13 (Green Shift, Lt. Burke) was on scene. Inside, MFD personnel was caring for patient Chaki L. JACKSON (m/b, 08-29-95) on the floor. MFD advised Squad 3430 that JACKSON was initially unconscious, but was now responsive. JACKSON likely had a seizure.

I then spoke to the general manager Angel L. STRAUER (f/w, 08-29-95) in the manager's office. STRAUER typically works from 9 AM to 7 PM., and can be reached at (414) 488-4268. STRAUER said that JACKSON was scheduled to work at 4:00 PM, but came to work at approximately 9:30 PM. STRAUER said at approximately 11:25 PM, she heard employees scream. STRAUER said she came to the "sandwich making station," and observed JACKSON laying down. JACKSON's eyes rolled in the back of his head. JACKSON described laying him in a recovery position, and awaited MFD response.

P.O. TOLENTINO spoke with the caller Jonathan N. THOMAS (m/b, 02-04-81) who was working beside JACKSON at the "sandwich making station." THOMAS said he heard a scream, and watched JACKSON jump upwards, and fell onto his back. THOMAS then described watching his body shake as JACKSON was having a seizure.

Med 13 conveyed JACKSON to St. Joseph's Hospital for medical treatment. On Monday, October 23, 2023 at 12:10 AM, Jackson was treated by Dr. HERNANDEZ.

STRAUSER was cooperative. I did not review surveillance footage, but they were working at that time.

Per the district community partnership unit, this location is a license premise and business in the Washington Park Neighborhood.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/29/2024 at 2:35 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or [stasst5@milwaukee.gov](mailto:stasst5@milwaukee.gov) for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**
