If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, lilegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

On 11/11/2021 at 10:22pm officers were dispatched to a Shooting at Clark gas station, 2175 N. 35th St. The officers interviewed the clerk, who stated there was no shots fired and no shooting in the parking lot. The clerk stated there are no exterior cameras and the interior cameras do not record.

9. On 02/02/2022 at 11:17pm officers were dispatched to a Shooting at Clark gas station, 2175 N. 35th St. The officers located a victim inside the station with gunshot wounds to his hand and foot. The scene was located in the alley behind the gas station. The victim stated he was walking to the gas station when he heard gunshots and felt pain. He then ran into the station

to call police. The employees were cooperative. The officers were able to access the video system but found the system has not been recording since June 2021.

- 10. On 05/30/23 at 10:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2175 N. 35th St, for an armed robbery/carjacking complaint. Officer spoke with the victim, who stated that her vehicle was taken at gun point, while she was parked at the gas station. The victim stated that the suspects took her vehicle without consent and left the area in her vehicle. Officers reviewed video of the incident obtaining suspect's description and actions of the incident. Officers were able to located the victim's vehicle unoccupied parked a few blocks away. The vehicle was towed to the city tow lot for investigative purposes.
- 11. On 07/03/23 at 5:25pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2175 N. 35th St, for a shooting complaint. Officers located the victim lying on the floor of the business with a gunshot wound to the knee area. The victim stated that he was pumping gas at the location. While getting gas an unknown vehicle, pulled behind his vehicle and gun shots were fired towards his direction. The victim stated that he did not see the shooter. Officers spoke with the clerk regarding video. The employee stated that the exterior cameras were not operable, and no surveillance footage was recovered of the incident.

On Tuesday, May 30th, 2023 at approximately 10:30 pm Squad 3240, P.O. Jazzmin KING and I were

dispatched to 2175 N. 35th St, which is located in the City and County of Milwaukee for an Armed Robbery/Carjacking complaint.

Upon arrival, we met with the caller/victim, Jakarri A. EDWARDS (B/F, 11-22-2003) who stated on Tuesday, May 30th, 2023 at the above location, an unknown suspect intentionally and without consent held her at gunpoint and stole her vehicle.

Interview of Victim:

EDWARDS stated on Tuesday, May 30th, 2023, she met a male subject by the name of "Keytavion" on Facebook. EDWARDS stated while she was in Racine, she came to meet with "KEYTAVION" here in Milwaukee, EDWARDS stated did not know what time she came to Milwaukee or what time she met with "KEYTAVION". EDWARDS stated when she picked up "KEYTAVION", he stated his brothers were getting inside of the vehicle. EDWARDS stated she did not know the location where she picked up the subjects. EDWARDS stated she drove around with the 3 subjects all day. EDWARDS stated she took the subjects to the gas station (Clark, 2175 N. 35th St.) because they needed to get some items. EDWARDS stated "KEYTAVION" and his brothers then went inside of the gas station. EDWARDS stated that when the subjects came out of the gas station, "KEYTAVION" and one of the brothers walked to the side of the gas station. EDWARDS stated the 3rd brother walked back to the vehicle. EDWARDS stated he then told her "you have to get the f*ck out" and point a black firearm with an orange tip at her. EDWARDS stated she did not know her vehicle's plate #, but the vehicle was in her name. EDWARDS stated her vehicle is a 2009 Toyota Scion, Red in color, 4 door.

Suspect description:

EDWARDS stated suspect 1, "KEYTAVION" was a black male, 20 years of age, light complexion, sandy brown hair with a nappy afro, green eyes, and last seen wearing black joggers and a black jacket.

EDWARDS stated suspect 2, was a black male, dark complexion, medium build, and last seen wearing a black ski mask. EDWARDS stated his name was "WILL".

EDWARDS stated suspect 3 was a black male, light complexion, medium build, and last seen wearing a black ski mask.

VIDEO FOOTAGE:

The gas station security (who wanted to remain anonymous) led me behind the county to view footage of the incident. I viewed video footage at the above location, where I observed the incident on Camera 5. At approximately 10:01 P.M. Edwards' vehicle pulls inside of the gas station and parks at pump 5. At approximately 10:02 P.M., 3 male subjects walked inside of the gas station from EDWARDS' vehicle. At approximately 10:02:37 P.M., the 3 male subjects then walked out of the gas station. Subjects 2 and 3 then walk together to the left side of the gas station. Subject 1 then walks back to EDWARDS vehicle. At approximately 10:03 P.M, EDWARDS' vehicle then pulls off heading westbound and EDWARDS walks

inside of the gas station and speaks with the clerk.

The security stated the gas station had no working cameras on the outside.

Suspect Description From Video:

Subject 1: black male, medium brown complexion, and last seen wearing black hoodie with orange design on front, black pants, gray crocs, and black ski mask (armed with a black firearm with orange tip)

Subject 2: black male, medium brown complexion, and last seen wearing a black shirt, black jacket, black jogging pants with white stripes on the side, black and white tennis shoes, and black ski mask.

Subject 3: black male, medium brown complexion, nappy afro, and last seen wearing red, white, and blue jacket, blue jeans with orange stripes on the side, and white and black shoes. (EDWARDS' IDENTIFIED AS "KEYTAVION")

It should be noted that EDWARDS Iphone 12 pro max was inside of the vehicle. EDWARDS used the gas station's security guard cell phone to use "Find my Iphone" to locate her cell phone. The location of EDWARD'S cell phone was on 38th and wright.

Squad 3210, Sergeant, Nicholas DANKERT and Squad 3241, P.O. Daniel GOODCHILD and P.O. Michael MARX, responded to 38th and wright. Sgt. DANKERT located a vehicle, matching EDWARDS' vehicle description at the location of 2461 N. 38th st. The vehicle had an IL PLATE of CR36225, VIN: JTLKE50E791094845. The vehicle was unoccupied.

P.O. GOODCHILD and MARX did a canvas regarding, see supplement.

Squad 3431, P.O. Devin Whitefield, received video footage from the gas station and processed EDWARDS' vehicle.

The vehicle was towed to the City tow lot.

During my investigation for the armed robbery, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

On Monday, July 3rd, 2023, at approximately 5:25 P.M., P.O. Michael WITKOWSKI and I were dispatched to a Shooting Complaint located at 2175 N 35th St.

Upon our arrival I observed the victim, identified as Ladarius D JOHNSON (B/M, 01/19/2004), lying on the ground inside of the Clark Gas Station (2175 N 35th St) with a gunshot wound to his left knee. I was able to briefly interview JOHNSON prior to medical personnel arriving. At which time, JOHNSON stated that he had been pumping gas at a pump on the south side of the parking lot when a dark colored newer model dodge dart pulled up behind his vehicle and the suspect began firing shots towards him. He stated he observed no suspect description of the shooter. JOHNSON's vehicle, a Black 2010 Mazda 3 was parked at the gas station lot and was struck several times, along with the pump it was parked next to.

A witness, Asia R SMALL (B/F, 10/4/98), stated she was seated in the front passenger seat of the Mazda, facing away from the suspect vehicle, when the shots were fired, and did not observe the suspects nor the vehicle they were driving.

CIB personnel on scene (Squads 9245, 9254, 9242) did speak with the gas station clerk. The business had 0 security officers on scene.

Officers on scene were told that the several security cameras on the exterior of this location are not operable, and therefore there was no surveillance footage recovered of the incident.

During my investigation for the shooting complaint, I did not observe any violations in the licensed premise.

A total of eleven squads responded to the scene.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/17/2023 at 10:40 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel — Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable — or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via phone or internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
