#### **Executive Summary**

The Corliss is a 576-unit Affordable Housing New Construction project at the former Filer & Stowell complex at 135 East Becher Street in the Bay View /Harbor District neighborhood of Milwaukee.

The project is led by Bear Development (Bear), with Construction Management Associates (CMA) as the General Contractor. Prism Technical Management & Marketing Services, LLC (Prism) has been contracted to assist in the achievement of project inclusion requirements: 40% RPP workforce; and SBE contract spend of 25% Construction and 18% Professional Services.

Bear is committed to the letter and spirit of the City of Milwaukee Human Resource Agreement requiring the utilization of Contractors, Consultants, and other service providers reflective of the diversity of the City of Milwaukee.

While not the subject of this report it is noted that this development also has goals under a Low-Income housing Tax Credit LIHTC agreement with WHEDA.

The Corliss project is exceeding all of its City of Milwaukee inclusion requirements, with 67.7% Professional SBE participation, 30.8% Construction SBE participation, 50.8% RPP certified workforce participation, and an impressive 56.8% apprentice RPP utilization rate.







**Chart 3: Workforce Participation** 


