There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or mixed the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by PO Seth EDWARDS, assigned to District 1, Late Power shift.

On Saturday, December 05, 2015 at approximately 1:00 AM, Squad 1430 (myself) was flagged down by a security member from the NOVO security team at the intersection of N. Water St and E. Juneau St for subjects fighting in front of Buffalo Wild Wings, located at 1123 N. Water St, which is in the city and county of Milwaukee.

Upon my arrival, I observed a security member of NOVO'S security team who was later identified as, Mazin M. SHERID (B/M 11-19-93) who had the subject, who was later identified as Lyth B. SAEED (W/M 05-29-94). detained on the steps of Buffalo Wild Wings. As I approached SHERID and SAEED I contacted dispatch to notify them of my location. SHERID stated that the subject had a gun. I observed the subjects hands were behind his back but un-cuffed. SAEED was able to get to his feet and I immediately took control of his left arm while SHERID controlled his right. I asked SHERID where the gun was on SAEED and SHERID stated that it was in his waistband on the backside of his waist. I immediately located the gun where SHERID stated it was and removed it from his body with my right hand. SAEED attempted to move to his right and I took control of SAEED with my left hand around his torso. SHERID and I guided SAEED to the ground. I contacted dispatch while on the ground with SAEED and stated that I was on the ground with the SAEED that I had removed a gun from him and that he was un-cuffed. Squad 1445 (PO Eric BRANDT) arrived first on scene and I passed the gun to him. PO BRANDT took control of the gun I removed from SAEED. I took control of SAEED'S right arm and placed it behind his back. SHERID took control of his left arm and placed it behind his back. I placed handcuffs on SAEED and conducted a search for other possible weapons on him. I moved SAEED to his feet after I conducted my search and found no other weapons. I took SAEED to Squad 1490 (PO Christopher PETERSON) and placed him in the back of the Police wagon. While placing SAEED in the back of the wagon I detected the odor of an intoxicating beverage on his breath as he spoke myself and other officers about the situation.

I went back to NOVO to conduct an interview of witnesses. I interviewed a security member involved in the initial incident, who was later identified as Ricardo M. GARCIA (H/M 01-12-97).

Interview of GARCIA:

GARCIA stated that he was inside of NOVO when he noticed a commotion. GARCIA stated that he and the other members of security approached to see what the issue was. GARCIA stated that SAEED stated to him an individual touched his girlfriend's buttocks. GARCIA stated that he and the security team was able to remove all parties involved from the establishment. GARCIA stated that once outside SAEED was still yelling at security members. GARCIA stated that SHERID told SAEED "Go home before the police get involved." GARCIA stated that SAEED stated "Oh yeah? You know what I'm going to do about it?" and lifted his shirt revealing a green semi-automatic pistol in his waistband on his left hip. GARCIA stated that SHERID immediately grabbed SAEED and took him to the ground. GARCIA stated that he then went to go look for Police Officers to notify.

SAEED was conveyed by Squad 1490 to Central Booking to be processed.

While on scene, Agent DORN lead the tavern check and generated a field report based on her findings. In that report, Agent DORN noted the following for the tavern:

- Invoices must be separated by vender and kept in sequential order.
- Must have licensed operator on premises during all business hours.
- No pre-made alcoholic drinks in premises for longer than one business day.
- Must "X" out labels prior to recycling.

While on scene, Bashir FOTOUHI (W/M, 06-20-84) was identified as the only employee/occupant of the premise. Agent DORN requested to see a copy of FOTOUHI's license to bartend. FOTOUHI stated that he could not provide that as he did not have a valid license to bartend. FOTOUHI stated that he had taken a course to obtain the license but never actually obtained it. FOTOUHI was cited on scene.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

This report is submitted by P.O. BOGUST assigned to District One, Power Shift, squad 1460. On Sat March 26th, at approximately 1:57 AM I conducted a tavern check at 789 N Jefferson ST (Bad Genie LLC). A patron informed me that he believed the bar was way over its operating capacity and was a fire risk. I contacted Sgt ACKLEY, who coordinated additional squads to assist in my tavern check.

I entered the establishment and immediately noticed the bar was very crowed. I talked with the on duty manager Elias M JIMENEZ (w/m 04/12/86) and asked him how many patrons were in the bar? He was unable to provide any count at all, I also noticed that there was no one standing by the door checking identifications or acting as a bouncer which is common at most bars. JIMENEZ informed me that one of the bouncers called in sick and the other bouncer just left half way through his shift.

SGT ACKLEY counted and video taped all patrons exiting the establishment with his body camera. I was stationed right at the bottom of the stairwell that leads up to the second floor of the establishment. I also had a body camera activated and observed a large continuous crowed coming down the stairs. SGT VILJEVAC was also in the bar observing the large crowd and recording the activity on his body camera.

This bars total occupancy on their permit from the City of Milwaukee is 182 patrons. The total count of patrons and employees in the bar was 304. The tavern was over capacity by 122 people.

I reviewed the posted license prior to my departure with the assistant owner Ryan T BONEN (w/m 05/06/84). I also informed him he will be receiving an over occupancy citation with in a few days.

- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

On the evening of Friday, August 7, 2015 through the morning of Saturday, August 8, 2015 District One personnel performed an underage tavern enforcement initiative. There were three teams that were part of this initiative. Each team had an MPD Police Aide, a Police Officer, both of which were acting in a plainclothes capacity with a uniformed Police Officer or Sergeant monitoring from a short distance. The Police Aide for each team was under the age of 21. This was verified by their respective Wisconsin driver's license. Police Aide Laura Nirode (PS 024687, DOB 6/15/95), Police Aide Elizabeth Sauer (PS 024693, DOB 8/11/94), PA Chelsey McDowell (PS 024685, 8/16/94), PO Karlee Kennon (PS 021519), PO Dorian Andress (PS 019758) and PO Kira Williams (PS 019786) were in plainclothes while PO Mariolys Flores (PS 024325), PO Zachary Johnson (PS 022614) and Sergeant Thomas Ackley (PS 018520) were in full uniform.

Prior to attempting any checks of licensed establishments the Police Aides and Police Officers were given instructions. All plainclothes members of this initiative were advised they are not allowed to consume any intoxicating beverages. If asked about their age, the members were told to tell the truth. The Police Officers were directed to produce ID's, but the underage Police Aides were directed to not produce any form of identification. It was explained that the Police Aide was to order an alcoholic beverage. It was explained that at all times the plainclothes Police Officer should be in visual sight and observe the financial transaction for alcoholic beverages. All plainclothes members of this initiative submitted a sample of their breath to a PBT test before and after the initiative. All members registered 0.0% BAC.

After the briefing, the teams conducted underage checks at multiple taverns and convenient stores located throughout the District One boundaries.

Police Officer Kira Williams and Police Aide Elizabeth Sauer attempted to gain entry to the class "B" licensed tavern, Dino's Taverna located at 777 N. Jefferson St. Williams and Sauer entered the tavern without being challenged at the point of entry. Sauer stated that there was a bouncer at the door, described as a B/M, 25-30 years of age, 5'10, 200-250 lbs., shoulder length dreadlocks, with a beard wearing a black shirt and black pants. Once inside, Sauer purchased a Coors Light beer at the bar for \$4.00. The bartender who served Sauer was a W/F, 45-55 years of age, shoulder length brown hair wearing a red button up shirt and black pants.

On Wednesday, August 19, 2015 at 8:51 p.m. I, Police Officer Mariolys Flores informed Dino Zarkos, the owner that they failed. While at the tavern, I asked Zarkos if they had a ID scanner, at which time Zarkos replied that they did not.

This report is written by P.O. Guadalupe RAMIREZ-CERVANTES, assigned to the Neighborhood Task Force, Street Crime Unit.

On Friday, 01-01-15, at approximately 2:16 AM, SQ. 950 (P.O. Eligio CAVAZOS and I) were flagged down by citizens running out of the rear entrance at Dino's Taverna (777 N Jefferson St).

The frightened citizens stated that there was a huge fight inside and that someone "Got their head busted." I then called out the fight over the police radio. SQ. 1460 (P.O. Raymond BOGUST) was the first on scene at the front entrance. P.O. BOGUST observed several individuals running out of the establishment. P.O. BOGUST stated that he observed 10 to 15 black males pushing, yelling, shoving and causing a disturbance. P.O. BOGUST stated that he then radioed for additional squads to help control the disturbance.

The large group disbursed as additional squads responded. I observed a blood trial leading inside Dino's. SQ. 1212 (Sgt. Cory STREY), P.O. BOGUST, P.O. CAVAZOS and I then entered the establishment. I was able to observe broken glass near the front entrance and blood on the floor. Citizens inside were still in shock over what had occurred inside.

I located the owner behind the bar who identified himself as Dean ZARKOS (W/M, 05-25-54) by Wisconsin DL. When asked what had occurred, ZARKOS said, "It blew up. We kicked them out". ZARKOS then stated that he had only two security officers working tonight and "What was I supposed to do?" ZARKOS stated that he was not going to close the bar after the incident even after officers addressed his lack of security.

The bartenders and security wanted to close the bar due to the safety concerns, but ZARKOS did not want to. Due to the large number of patrons causing a disturbance and so few Officers, we were unable to arrest anyone for disorderly conduct; we were only able to disburse the crowd. Due to the bartenders and security staff fearing for their safety, they closed the tavern without the owner's authorization.

I did locate the licenses near the front entrance door and they were visible to the public.

It should be noted that I was equipped with my body camera and it was on during the investigation.

ACKLEY with a copy of the Establisment's Occupancy permit that is required. ZARKOS stated he had the permit posted by the front door of the tavern but that a patron must have torn it down a while ago. We notified ZARKOS that we belived him to be over capacity and would be counting the patrons leaving and exiting the bar until bar close (2:30am). We observed a Security doorman to be at the front door but it did not appear that he had a device used to count entering patrons. PO Christopher PETERSON and PO Steven ROUFUS stationed outside the front door of the tavern so we could count the patrons. At no time did we impead the entering and exiting of the patrons. PO PETERSON was wearing a Milwaukee Police Department Body Camera that caught the tavern check and counted the Patrons exiting the tavern. I (PO FONS) was counting the patrons entering the tavern.

At the end of the tavern check we counted a total of 127 persons inside the establishment, which included tavern staff and patrons. ZARKOS was given the total number of patrons inside his tavern and was told he would be hand delivered citations in the future if he was in violation of City Ordinaces.

SGT ACKLEY contacted the city Attorney's office and was able to confirm that Dino's Taverna was in violation of their City of Milwaukee Occupancy Permit/ PEP License.
