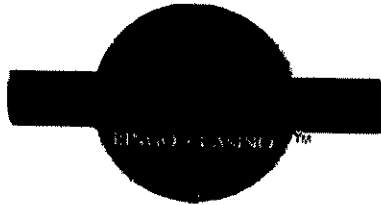

Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

I am writing to you on behalf of the Forest County Potawatomi Community and Potawatomi Bingo Casino to propose changing the names of the parcels of road that run on the east, south and west sides of the casino property to W. Potawatomi Circle. The streets impacted by this request are currently known as 16th Street, from Canal Street southerly to Pittsburgh Ave.; Pittsburgh Ave., from 16th Street westerly to S. 20th Street; and, S. 20th Street from Pittsburgh Ave. northerly to Canal Street to W. Potawatomi Circle, respectively.

This request was previously submitted under file #030407 in July 2003. Please note that the area covered in the original request has been expanded to include S. 20th Street from Pittsburgh Ave. northerly to canal Street. We would appreciate if this expanded area can be included within the original file documents.

As part of the Forest County Potawatomi Community's Intergovernmental Agency agreement with the City of Milwaukee, the Tribe was required to improve street access around the property. The work has been completed and we feel it is both logical and appropriate to change the name of the streets surrounding the property to reflect the name of the landowners. Improving street access is just one of the measures the Potawatomi tribe has undertaken to make the Menomonee Valley more accessible and aesthetically appealing.

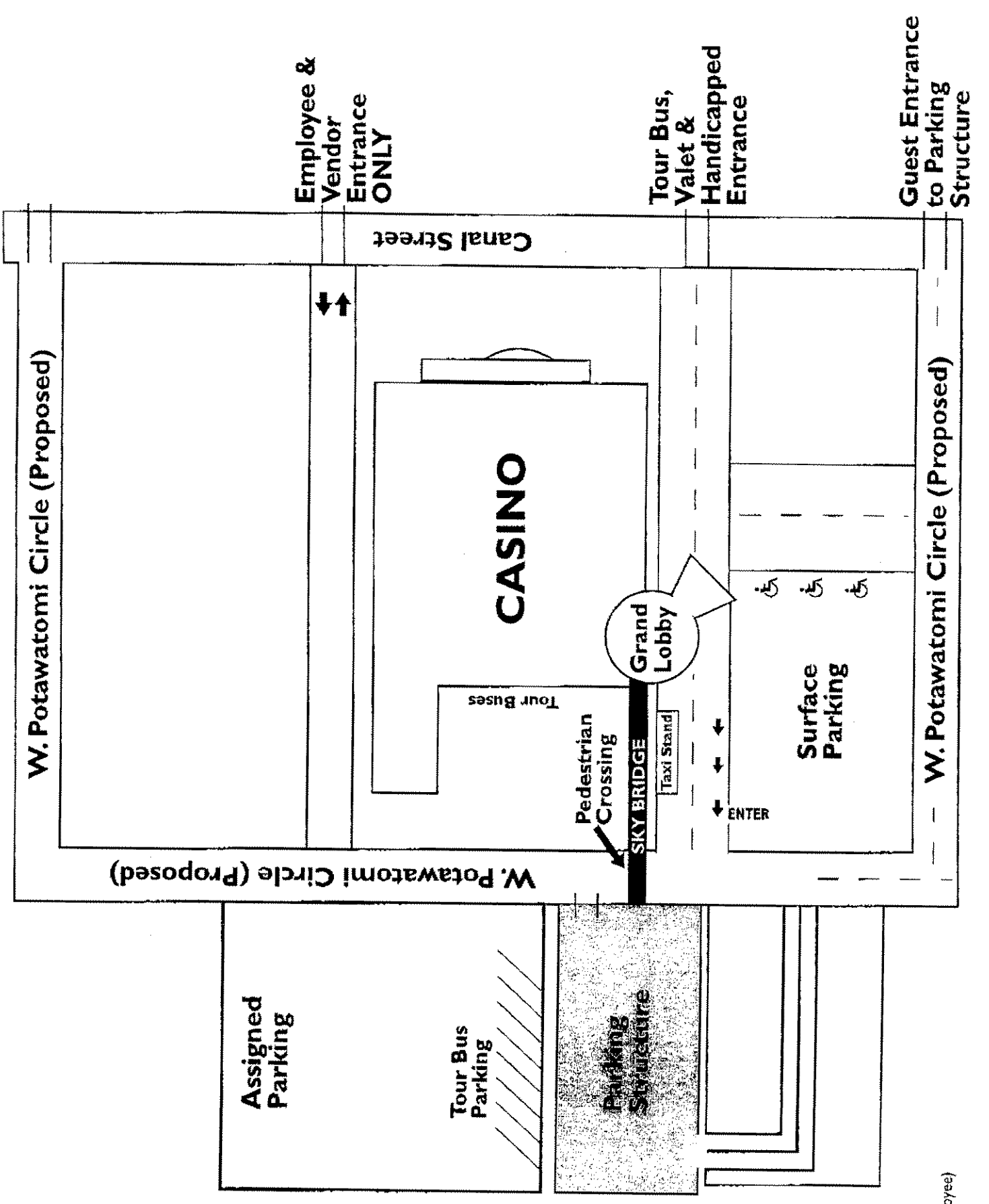
Enclosed you will find the required sketch of the streets impacted by this request. In addition, the Potawatomi tribe has provided a signed and notarized petition from greater than 50 percent of the landowners on the streets in this request. We hope that this petition format is acceptable as laid out in statute 113-3.4a-7; and, as required by the Street Naming Committee at their July 2003 meeting. The landowners along the streets in question include Emmepak Foods and the Forest County Potawatomi Community (owners of Potawatomi Bingo Casino), and their signatures are included. Repeated attempts to reach the owner of the Badger Railing property have been unsuccessful.


