There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 06/28/2012 the applicant was cited for Operating While Intoxicated. He was convicted on 07/18/2012 and his license was revoked for 6 months.
2. On 01/27/2018 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1226 W. National Av for

3. On 03/11/2019 at 2:11am officers investigated a subject with gun complaint at 1226 W. National Av. The officers spoke with security, who stated there had been a fight between two males. They escorted the subjects out and one of them punched security and broke a window. Security stated they did not want to prosecute for the incident.

4. On 04/01/2019 at 2:01am Officers were dispatched to a battery at 1226 W. National Av. The investigation revealed two patrons of the bar where fighting outside because of an incident that had occurred inside the bar prior to closing. The applicant was on scene but stated he was upstairs when the fight occurred. No tavern violations were observed.
5. On 06/08/2019 at 12:04am officers were dispatched to 1226 W. National Av to investigate a battery complaint. The investigation revealed a patron punched the security guard in the face and fled the scene. The subject was located and identified as being 19 years old. He stated he entered the bar without being asked for ID and consumed alcohol while on scene. The officers were unable to speak with the applicant because it was after bar closing time when the subject was located.

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6. On 07/21/20 at 11:39am, the Milwaukee Police Tactical Enforcement Unit conducted a search warrant at 1226-1228 W. National Avenue. The applicant was located in the upstairs living area along with cocaine, marijuana, and items used to package and sell these products. The applicant was arrested and the actual tavern was searched but did not contain anything of evidentiary value.
7. On 08/17/20 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1226 W. National Avenue for Build Code Violations.

8. On 11/18/20 at 10:57pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1226 W. National Avenue for a subject with weapon complaint. Officer's interviewed the applicant who stated that there was a fight between three brothers, who are regular customers, and one of them threatened to break his window with a rock. The applicant was cooperative with the investigation and told to call back if the brothers returned.
9. On 12/28/20 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1339 S. 9th Street for Building Code Violations.

10. On 02/14/21 at 1:23am, Milwaukee Police, along with the Milwaukee Health Department, conducted a license premise check at 1226 W. National Avenue. The Environmental Health Specialist observed several individuals standing in close proximity of one another and nobody had face masks on. The Environmental Health Specialist told the applicant he was going to issue citations for not wearing face masks and standing. (As of 06/23/21, no citations were found for violations regarding this incident.)

11. On 03/02/21 at 1:21am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1226 W. National Avenue for a sexual assault complaint. Investigation revealed that a patron had her breast grabbed by another patron inside the establishment. The victim's boyfriend punched the actor and the applicant broke up the altercation. The victim called police and the applicant (who did not call police) was cooperative with police. No tavern violations were observed.

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Items 7 & 9 were updated with disposition and warrant status
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12. On 07/09/23 at 2:25a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon at 1226 W. National Ave. Investigation revealed a physical altercation took place inside the establishment between patrons. The agent was notified and came downstairs and sprayed pepper spray in an attempt to disperse the crowd. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

13. On 09/24/23 at 1:26a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with a Gun at 1226 W. National Ave. Investigation revealed a subject was removed from the tavern due to causing a disturbance. The subject then fired multiple shots into the establishment, causing damage to the exterior. The subject fled the scene and officers. The subject crashed a short time later. Officers recovered spent casings and magazines in the unoccupied vehicle. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

14. On 12/14/23 at 12:40a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 1226 W. National Ave. Officers interviewed the agent who stated he observed two subjects from opposing gangs making threats to shoot one another, however, did not observe any weapons. The agent did not want the subjects removed, as they did not want involvement in any potential conflicts. The agent requested increased police presence.

15. On 04/29/24 at 1:36a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Property Damage at 1226 W. National Ave. Officers observed a subject who stated they were in pain due to being pepper sprayed at the location. Officers interviewed the agent as well as several witnesses who stated they patron was causing a disturbance in the bar and engaged in a physical altercation, at which time the agent pepper sprayed the subject and called for police. The agent stated officers could come back to view video surveillance once they retrieved the password.

16. On 07/30/24 at 8:30p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 1226 W. National Ave., regarding a complaint of underage bartenders. Assisting in this assignment were Agents from Wisconsin Department of Revenue Alcohol and Tobacco Division. On arrival officers found the business open and one employee inside (33yo), who initially stated they were the bartender, however, then recanted and stated they were just opening up for the owner who lives upstairs. The DOR Agent found the following violations:

- No Licensed Operator on Premise
- Seller's Permit was not posted
- Beer Purchased from Unlicensed Distributors

- Defaced Labels
- Contaminated Liquor
- Missing Invoices

The Agent confiscated at total of 139 Liquor bottles, both open and unopened. The Agent advised the business agent this would be an educational visit and made suggestions to correct the violations.

17. Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1226 W. National Ave., for Noise Complaints on the following dates:

- 07/21/23 at 9:46pm Music could be heard on officer's body cam from two properties away. Officers advised the business to close the door and lower the music
- 07/23/23 at 12:51am No loud music could be heard from the premise
- 09/09/23 at 10:29pm The officer determined the loud music was not coming from the premise
- 02/10/24 at 9:52pm Caller cancelled the squad because music was turned down
- 02/13/24 at 12:30am Body cam showed music could not be heard until the door was open. The employee agreed to lower the music.

18. On October 18, 2024, at approximately 12:21 pm, Milwaukee Police Officers executed a search warrant in the tavern and residential units of 1226 W National Av. The warrant was requested because officers were investigating a shot fired incident from the residential unit and the applicant was the suspect. Officers recovered cocaine, drug paraphernalia, a suspected drug sales ledger, and 9mm cartridges. Chickens were also located in the basement of the tavern. The applicant was arrested, charges have been referred to the District Attorney's Office.

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19. On 11/28/24 at 1:40a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 1226 W. National. The Agent stated two patrons punched them prior to leaving. The Agent stated there were no security officers working and the video surveillance does not work.

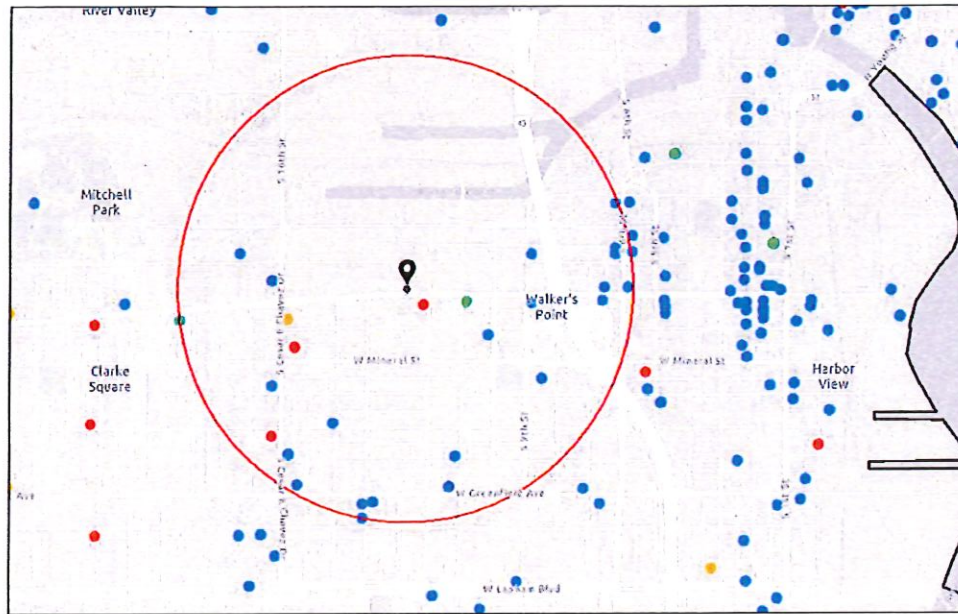


Concentration Map 1226 W National Ave

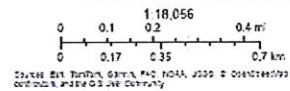

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/19/2026 at 10:30 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.



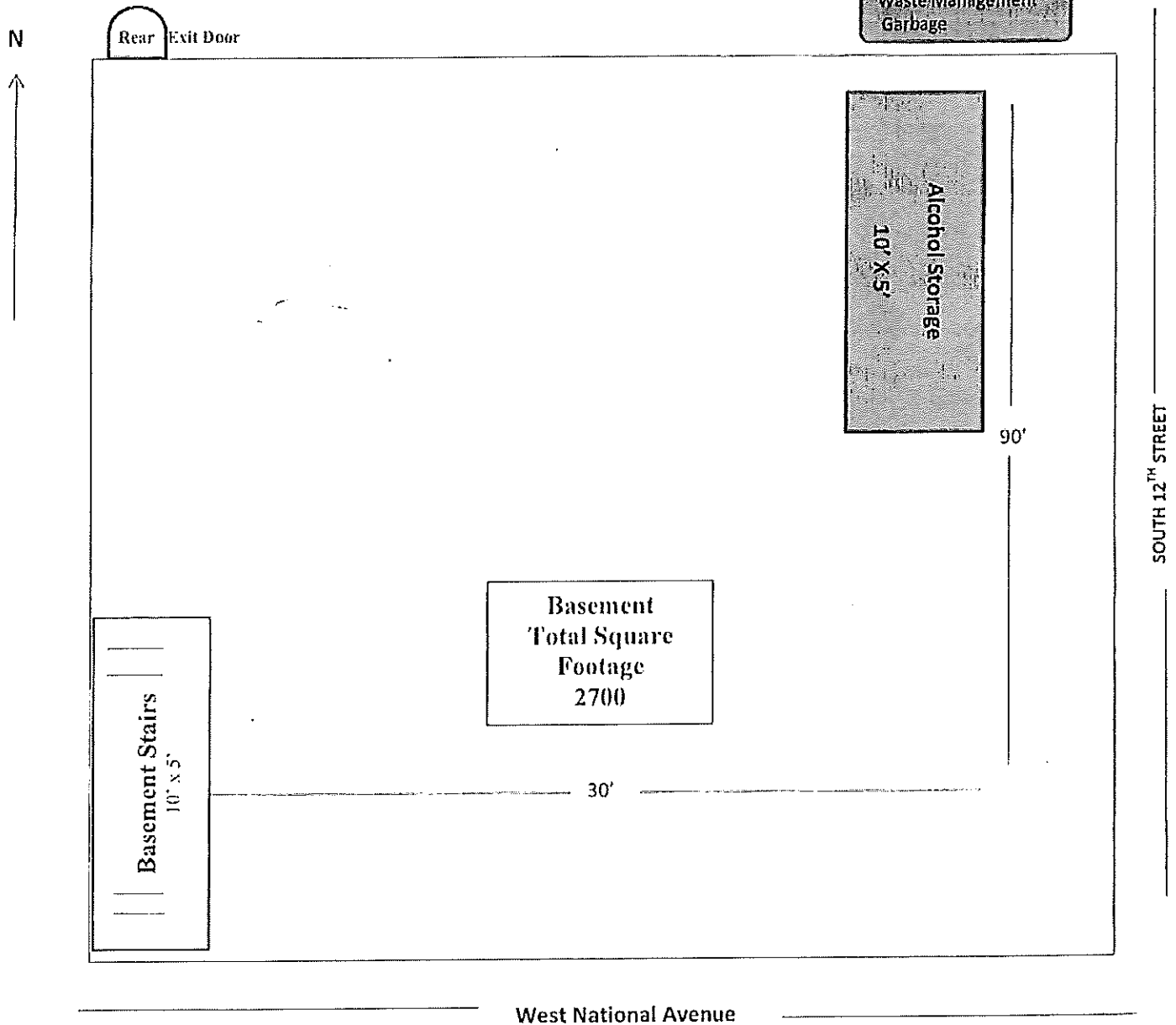

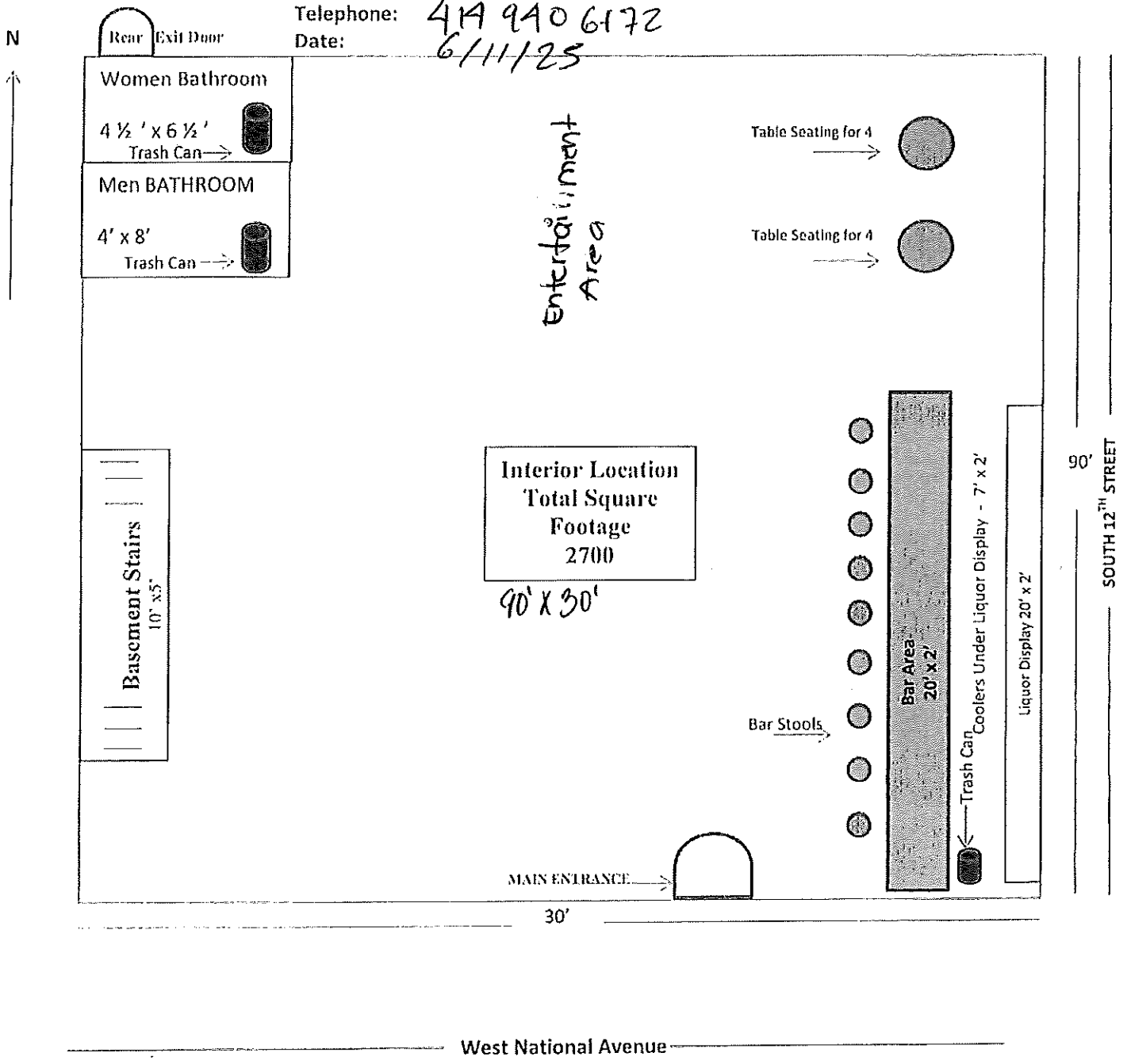
