Dear Honorable Members:


In the attached copy of a letter from Ms. Peggy A. West, Co-chair of the Cesar E. Chavez Drive Advancement Committee, it is requested that the City of Milwaukee change the name of South 16th Street between West Windlake Avenue and West Mitchell Street, to South Cesar E. Chavez Drive.

The name change will honor the late Cesar Estrada Chavez, a farmworker organizer and leader of a labor movement which adhered to the principles of non-violence.

This name change will extend the limits of South Cesar E. Chavez Drive, which presently runs from West Mitchell Street to West Pierce Street.

There are 193 abutting ownership which would be affected by this proposed name change.
