Notice is hereby given that an ordinance (passage of which is now pending) was introduced at the September 21, 2004 meeting of the Milwaukee Common Council, the essence of which is as follows:

Substitute ordinance approving the change in zoning from Multi-Family Residential (RM2) to Multi-Family Residential (RM4), on land located on the East Side of South 3rd Street between West Pierce Street and West Bruce Street, in the 12th Aldermanic District.

Resolved, That the Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee, do ordain as follows:

Part I There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-50(3)(c).0003. The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for the area bounded by the zoning line within the right-of-way of West Pierce Street, the zoning line within the right-of-way of South 3rd Street, the zoning line within the right-of-way of West Bruce Street and a line 150 feet East and parallel to the east line of South 3rd Street, from Multi-Family Residential (RM2) to Multi-Family Residential (RM4).

Notice is hereby further given that the foregoing matter will be given a public hearing by the Committee on Zoning, Neighborhoods and Development in Room 301-B, City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin, on Tuesday, November 16, 2004 at 9:00 A.M., pursuant to the provision of Sub-Section (7)(d) of Section 62.23 of the Revised Statutes of the State of Wisconsin.

PLEASE NOTE: a) Members of the Common Council, and members of its Standing Committees who are not members of this Committee, may attend this meeting to participate or to gather information. Therefore, notice is given that this meeting may constitute a meeting of the Common Council or any of its Standing Committees, and must be noticed as such, although they will not take any formal action at this meeting.

b) If you have difficulty with the English language, you may bring an interpreter with you, at your own expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in the hearing.

c) Upon reasonable notice, efforts will be made to accommodate the needs of disabled individuals through sign language, interpreters or other auxiliary aids.
