Please be advised that I have completed my review of the above-captioned complaint filed against Officer Weslowski and dating back to April 28, 1999. Officer Weslowski had been the subject of a complaint filed by a co-worker regarding some language which he used at the City Tow Yard which is where he was assigned at that point. A charging conference was held on May 26, 1999 in the presence of Lt. David Bruess, Det. Cowan, Officer Weslowski, and his Attorney Jon Cermele. At that conference I advised Officer Weslowski of the allegations against him which he stated he understood. At that time, the officer maintained that he never made threats to harm or cause fear to others, nor did he use obscenities during his conversation with the complainant on the date in question.

During the course of our meeting, however, I strongly recommended that Officer Weslowski seek professional counseling through his private physician and/or the Employee Assistance Program. Officer Weslowski readily agreed to do so.

I have since been informed that those counseling services have been obtained through the Office of Employee
