Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

I represent Nail F. Mseitif, agent for Nail & Ahsraf, LLC. This letter is intended to be construed as written objection on behalf of my client to the report and recommendation of the Licenses Committee dated June 4, 2010.

My client does not object to the written Findings of Fact as summarized in the report, except that Paragraph 5 (C) of the Findings does not include any reference to positive testimony for my client. Ashraf Warda, a member of the LLC and current manager of the business, testified that the business has responded promptly to all complaints and is attempting to improve relationships with neighbors and community groups such as Grantosa Heights Neighborhood Block Watch. Examples given regarding prompt responses to complaints were the immediate installation of an additional exterior security camera, at the request of Alderman Davis, and the immediate removal of items for sale that could be construed as promoting drug use or consumption, at the request of Milwaukee Police.

My client objects primarily to the recommendation of the License Committee that the license be renewed with a ten (10) day suspension. It is submitted that a ten (10) day suspension of my client's Class "A" Liquor and Malt license is overly harsh and unnecessary based upon all of the facts pertaining to this license.
