A Proud History: Why change the name of the street?

The Cesar E. Chavez Drive Committee began with the vision of one man, the late Marshall G. Vega. In November of 1995 Mr. Vega, a community activist called Alderman Jim Witkowiak's office to find out what the process was to change the name of a street. After receiving and reviewing that information, he assembled a small committee of community residents, activists, leaders and business owners who became known as "The Cesar E. Chavez Renaming Committee". Marshall wanted to name a street for a Hispanic American because there were no such streets in all of Wisconsin even though many Hispanics live, work and contribute greatly to our communities. He wanted to name the street for Cesar because Mr. Chavez is someone who is greatly admired by people all over the world for standing up for a people who until Chavez came along were forgotten about by the rest of the world, Migrant Farmworkers.

The rest is history. In August of 1996 the CEC Renaming committee appeared before the Common Council to lobby for So. 16th Street from Pierce to Mitchell Street to become So. Cesar E. Chavez Drive. The Common Councils one concern at that time was that Chavez Dr. would not go clear through the community making it confusing for people who are not from this area to find their way. Immediately upon leaving the Common Council meeting, Marshall began researching how we could continue our renaming efforts and make So. 16th Street from Pierce to Windlake Avenue, So. Cesar E. Chavez Drive.

Marshal G. Vega passed away on April 11th, 1999 after losing a courageous battle with Renal Cell Kidney Cancer one of his last wishes was that our committee come together again and make his vision for Chavez Drive a reality.
