Subject: Question on the Emerging Business Enterprise Program

At the October 7, 2005 Finance and Personnel Committee Budget Hearing, several questions were asked of the Department of Administration regarding the Emerging Business Enterprise Program.

1. Is it possible to provide the Committee with EBE best practices in peer cities research before amendment day?

The scheduled amendment days are November 3 and 4. Research of EBE best practices in peer cities cannot be completed before these dates. However, identifying best practices that contribute to contracting opportunities for emerging businesses (including but not limited to certification processes, bid processes, loan programs, payment processes and advertising) in other cities is one of the tasks that is included in the Scope of Services for a Request for Proposals for "A Study to Determine the Effectiveness of the City of Milwaukee's Emerging Business Enterprise Program" that is being drafted.

2. Can DOA provide an update on the EBE tracking system?

The proposed schedule for BusinessSense, the EBE tracking system that will identify results by department, is as follows:
