REDESIGNATION OF THROUGH HIGHWAY STATUS ON  
WEST SCOTT STREET FROM SOUTH 21ST STREET TO  
SOUTH 31ST STREET

Dear Alderman Donovan:

With the introduction of the all-way stop on West Scott Street and South 31<sup>st</sup> Street, West Scott Street is no longer a continuous through highway segment from South 21<sup>st</sup> Street to South 31<sup>st</sup> Street.

Due to the interruption on the through highway based on the installation of the all-way stop control and to preserve the through highway status on West Scott Street and to provide safe operation on this roadway we recommend that the through highway designation be broken at the all-way stop location at South 30<sup>th</sup> Street.

Therefore, legislation will be prepared for consideration at the next Public Safety Committee meeting to alter the above-captioned traffic control.
