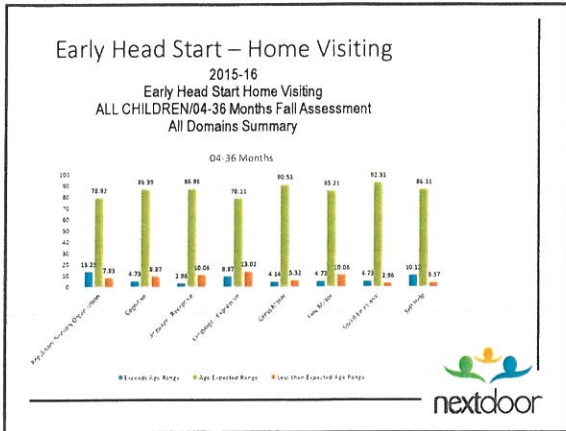

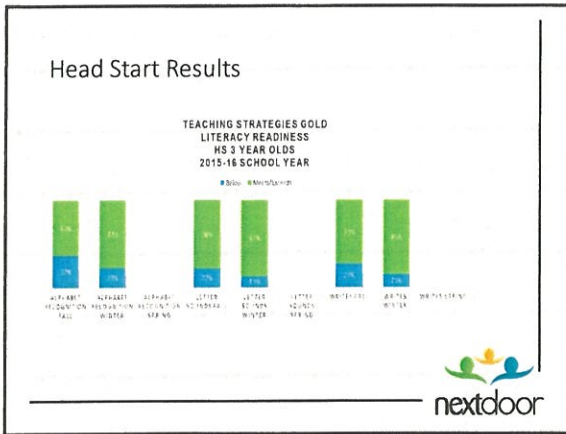


Next Door: Stronger Families through Education

- Increase from 166 students (currently all at 29th St site) to 485 students (at 29th St Site and Capitol site)
- 10 additional K4 classrooms
- 6 additional K5 classrooms

Proposed total:
