SUBSTITUTE 1

..Title

A substitute ordinance implementing state law regulating indoor and outdoor smoking of tobacco and tobacco products.

I move to amend Substitute 1 of File # 100242 so that the term "unenclosed place" is replaced with the term "outside areas" wherever it appears.

I further move to amend File #100242 to provide a new s. **105-48-5**.

Smoking Prohibited.

5. In addition to the chief of police and officers of the police department, the commissioners of the city departments of health and of neighborhood services, and their designees, are authorized to provide education about the state law and city ordinance, issue warnings and citations and to otherwise enforce city ordinances related to regulation of smoking.

..Analysis:

This amendment clarifies that an "unenclosed" place is an "outdoor area" consistent with state law. It further clarifies the definition of "substantial wall" to more clearly define an enclosed space consistent with definitions adopted by other Wisconsin jurisdictions.

The amendment also provides enforcement powers to the commissioners of health and neighborhood services and their designees.
