The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 11/09/2013 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 2008 W. Center St for Sale of Cigarettes to Minor/Underage.

2. On 08/30/2014 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 2008 W. Center St for Sale of Cigarettes to Minor/Underage.

- 3. On 02/19/19 at 1:21am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2008 W. Center Street for a Subject with Weapon Complaint. Investigation revealed that the cashier and a security guard for the establishment got into a physical altercation. During the fight, the cashier wielded a box cutter and the security guard had a stun gun. The security guard was arrested and the cashier was given a municipal citation.
- 4. On 05/13/19 at 9:48am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2008 W. Center Street for an accident complaint. Investigation revealed that a vehicle was backing up to one of the gas pumps, accelerated to fast, and struck the establishment.

- 5. On 12/11/19 at 10:39pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2008 W. Center St for a subject with weapon complaint. Investigation revealed that the suspect got into an altercation with security personal of the gas station, and had to be physically removed. The suspect left the gas station but returned driving his vehicle in a reckless manner. The suspect caused damage to two vehicles, belonging to the gas station clerk and the security officer. The suspect also struck both subjects while they were outside. The suspect was later arrested by Milwaukee Police.
- 6. On 06/02/20 at 4:29am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2008 W. Center St for a shooting complaint. The shooting occurred in the parking lot of the location with 3 total victims. One of the victims was a security guard for the gas station was pronounced dead by Milwaukee Fire Department at the scene. The other victims were conveyed to the hospital for medical treatment. The agent stated the gas station closed down around 11pm due to the current emergency order. He stated the security guard was in his car monitoring the parking lot. The agent slept inside the gas station. The agent was cooperative with the investigation, providing security footage regarding the incident.
- 7. On 06/02/20 at 9:13pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 2008 W. Center St for a shot spotter complaint. Officers attributed the shots being fired, to a shooting that took place earlier in the morning, at the same location. Officers arrived on scene and observed subjects still firing their guns, the subjects even fired shots in the direction of responding officers. Officers were able to take 4 subjects in custody, regarding the incident. The 4 subjects taken in custody all were armed with firearms.

8. On 10/31/20 at 6:14pm, officers investigated a complaint of a felon in possession of a firearm that was employed at RS Gas Station, 2008 W. Center St. Prior to arrival officers had ascertained the identity of the suspect and confirmed the suspect was in a convicted felon. Once on scene, officers identified and interviewed the suspect, however, no firearm was located on his person. The agent was on scene and cooperative, consenting to officers searching the premise. An officer entered the cooler area and observed drugs/narcotics, drug paraphernalia and US Currency, in a cardboard box on the floor. The agent allowed the officers to watch surveillance video, which depicted the suspect inside the locked employee area, retrieve a silver handgun from his pocket and place in the purse of the cashier, who was identified as the suspect's girlfriend. No employees admitted to the money or narcotics found. The agent was cooperative with the investigation.

- 9. On 03/07/21 at 12:30pm, officers conducted a license premise check at RS Gas Station, 2008 W Center. No violations were found and the employee was given a Standing Complaint Form regarding loitering.
- 10. On 03/09/21 at 11:15pm, officers were dispatched to a Reckless Use of Weapon at RS Gas Station, 2008 W Center. Officers interviewed the caller/security guard who stated multiple subjects were engaged in a physical altercation in the lot, climbing on and eventually breaking a window to a vehicle. The suspects then fled, when another vehicle began to drive at a group of people and attempt to strike them with the vehicle. All employees were cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view the video surveillance.

This license premise report is submitted by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift.

On 10-31-20 at 6:00 p.m., a citizen walked into the lobby of District 5, to report a convicted felon was working security at the RS LLC, gas station, located at 2008 W. Center St., which is a license filling station in the city of Milwaukee. This person was observed at the gas station with a firearm in his pocket. The citizen stated the person with a firearm was a black male, dreadlocks and wearing a baseball cap and named him by name.

Sq. 5240 (PO Casey DONAHUE and PO Benjamin RIVIERE) responded to District 5 to handle this call for service. Officers conducted a search of Wisconsin Circuit Court records revealed that this person is currently a convicted felon from a 2015 case and currently on active supervision with Wisconsin Department of Probation and Parole. This person was identified as Arthur L. SHAW (b/m 11-21-72)

Officers went to the gas station and observed the person identified at the gas station. Being on supervision, officers conducted an Act 79 search on this individual, but did not locate any firearms on his person. Officers observed a clerk working the front counter, Layaloni D. JACOBS (b/f 02-19-71) who stated she was SHAW's girlfriend and that he is working security at the gas station. The owner (agent) of the gas station, Sukwinder S. RANDHAWA (w/m 07-01-57) was also working at the gas station.

PO DONAHUE began to review the video, when SHAW began walking into the cooler area of the gas station. Due to the active investigation, PO DONAHUE asked RANDHAWA for consent to search for any firearms, which RANDHAWA gave his consent to search. PO DONAHUE entered the cooler area of the gas station and observed another worker in the cooler, John A. John A. RICHARDSON (b/m 01-28-72) to which he asked RICHARDSON to exit the cooler area and go to the front of the store. PO DONAHUE began to search the cooler area for any firearms. While doing this PO DONAHUE observed a brown cardboard box located on the floor of the cooler, which contained a large clear plastic baggie of a green plant like substance, suspected marijuana, clear plastic baggies, a black digital scale and US currency. Also observed was a clear plastic baggie which contained several multi-colored pills, suspected methamphetamine located in a box of drinks.

Once these items were located, PO DONAHUE continued to watch the store surveillance video. The video revealed that at 5:53 p.m., according to the video time stamp, SHAW placed a silver over black handgun in a pink purse, located behind the counter of the gas station. The video depicted SHAW in the secured clerk area, which employees are only allowed. JACOBS is serving customers, while SHAW walks behind JACOBS, take possession of her purse, reach into his right front pants pocket and retrieve a silver

over black semi-automatic handgun and place it into the purse.

SHAW then takes the purse and puts it back behind JACOBS. A search of the purse revealed a silver over black Walther PK 380, semi-automatic handgun.

The firearm was photographed and recovered and placed on inventory 200407277:

Silver and black Walther 380 Caliber PK380 with magazine, Serial #PK06594

The ammunition was placed on inventory 20040728:

8 HP 380 caliber brand hollow point cartridges.

The items located in the cooler were photographed and recovered. The items recovered from the cooler were placed on inventory 20040718:

Suspected marijuana was tested and tested positive for THC, 35.99 of marijuana, As well as another 1.08 grams of marijuana.

Recovered pills tested positive for Methamphetamine were 17 multi-colored pills with a Superman logo and had a weight of 4.69 grams.

Multi-colored pills with a Ghost logo, which also tested positive for Methamphetamine and had a weight of 1.66 grams.

Also tested was multi colored piece which only tested positive for Methamphetamine, weighing 0.41 grams.

The following items were placed on inventory 20040721:

US currency located was counted and the value of the money was \$232.25.

Digitz brand scale, along with the plastic baggies.

Neither SHAW nor RICHARDSON admitted to the money nor the narcotics.

At this time, it is unknown if the officers at the location had spoke to the agent further regarding any of the items located or if he had knowledge of this.

Officers on scene used two incident report numbers, 20-305-0160 and 20-305-0146. See their reports for a further detailed summary of this incident.



Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
