There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

Although not dramatically disturbing from (when closed), but when opened, Spanish music over a blk away; At lil after 2pm, a couple other trucks were loud when departing(loud mufflers)...zooming by with winding engines, Also going west; Finally, at least one of the remaining cars(parked but with lights on), blasting thumping music till leaving around 2:10 I did not call police , as I can't imagine someone in the immediate area didn't complain ??

Also, have you heard anything about the 11 shots fired weeks ago??
Did they apprehend anyone?, again just wondering?!

Hello Terri;

Writing this at 2:48 am(Oct 18th);
Didn't want to send it at this time (in case your cell is hooked up to email/forwarding);

Regarding the bar on 8th Oklahoma; exiting patrons were at it again;
congregating outside the bar/fairly loud,
but most disturbing again were revving/winding of engines, squealing tires/reckless driving, etc...

Called it in at roughly 2:30 am, but don't want to keep being the only one doing so....I know ive asked this before...but why can't the police hang out a Friday/Sat nite just before/at closing time??; Sat nite has usually been the worst of the 2 nites; Park hidden and observe??, ticket, etc?

Anyway...dealt with the noise/chaos initially, but several of the patrons vehicles kept doing the usual/up and down Oklahoma, several times-
so again, I called it in;
One vehicle, (think Chrysler 300/darker in color) squealed tires/racing engine...went blazing by-heading west along with another pick up racing alongside it??
One newer Blk pickup, repeatedly squealing tires; would speed up to 9th, U-turn on Oklahoma/squeal tires as doing so, Then race back down the almost 7th, U turn...come back again..... this went on for about 20 minutes;

Think that talk obviously didn't work....If they have hired bouncers?, why were people yet exiting the bar at 2:30 am?;Thought closing is 2pm?
Have police check those additional video cameras they supposedly installed for much of this!??

Also, was a pretty big group/crowd of vehicles again parked around the bar later in the nite (which has been common on Friday/Sat nites)...what about State Covid rules/restrictions? In addition to the 25% rule, sure don't see anyone wearing a mask entering or leaving...but im not watching all eve/nite...

As im finishing this email at 3:12 am and yet....cars with loud/blaring engines, speeding by...but can't say from the bar.... Maybe just the usual idiots this late at nite (or early morn you can say)...., at 3:18, finally has gotten quieter;

BTW, did hear 3 pops around 2:40 ish (2 and 1 after); could have been shots?, but may have been fireworks?...my windows were closed at the time..

To whomever it may concern,

I am reaching out in regards to the license application for El Relajo Bar on 733 W Oklahoma Ave, and would like to contribute an objection to the aforementioned application.

I am a resident of the neighbouring area within a fairly close proximity to the business—and have been for several years now—and am of the firm impression that the locale of choice for this business is unideal. Every morning without fail, the neighbourhood is made aware that El Relajo Bar is closing for the day; the customer-base often lingers outside causing racket for what can be hours on end, between shouting, revving their engines, racing along the streets in close quarters, and even harassing those of us who work third shift hours and are forced to go outside at this time. I have been made to feel like my safety is compromised on several occasions, with groups of men harassing me and following me to my vehicle when I am parked on the street. And on my off-days when I don't have to be up at these hours, I am often awakened by the patrons flooding our area before eventually dispersing—though never quietly.

Coincidentally, many vehicles on our block have been broken into with increasing frequency with the emergence of El Relajo Bar. I have no evidence that connotes a link between the two, though given the behaviour I have seen from many of the customer-base of El Relajo Bar, it would not necessarily surprise me.

Several months ago, I also had a peculiar incident where several women's purses were discarded along the walkway of my home. Empty as far as money goes, but still with identification cards, makeup, and other such amenities. I had turned them over to the Milwaukee Police Department and have since not heard anything further of the incident. Nothing of a similar nature has happened since that initial instance, however the circumstance in and of itself is something I continue to think about and I find very unsettling.

I feel if this license is permitted to this business, the noise complaints will persist more than ever, and further incidents will occur that bring myself and other women great discomfort. The location of El Relajo Bar should not be in such a condensed residential area if it wishes to expand its repertoire, and I am certain I am not the only resident that shares this sentiment.

Thank you for your time, as well as the opportunity to dispute the grant of this license.

For years, due to this Bar, there are constant drag races and people revving their engines outside at all hours. There is always empty cans and broken bottles strewn throughout the neighborhood. Their patrons park up the entire street where we all live leaving no room for us. The amount of shattered windows that happen on a regular basis can't be a coincidence. Multiple times now I have had stolen objects strewn in my backyard such as purses and wallets. None of this was the case before El Relajo. The place attracts people with no care or concern for the neighborhood with the fights and shouting all the time.

I feel like a boomer saying this but they have gone too far. This is not the area for a fucking Night Club.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/20/2018 officers conducted a licensed premise check on El Relajo, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. Upon entry the officer observed two people behind the bar, Itzel SANCHEZ CORREA, who had a valid Class D Operators license and Jose VIDRIO, who identified himself as the owner. There was a DJ located to the south of the entrance. The officer asked VIDRIO if he had a DJ listed on his license and VIDRIO stated he did not but was going to apply for one. The officer asked to see the licenses and found they were not posted. VIDRIO stated he must have left them at home. VIDRIO was cited for PEP license required and Not Posting of license.

2. On 09/27/2018 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 2082 S Muskego Av for Sale of Cigarettes to Minor/Underage.

3. On 03/31/2019 at 12:35am officers were dispatched to El Relajo, 733 W. Oklahoma Av, for underage subjects drinking in the bar. The officer spoke with a subject who identified himself as the manager. The officers found all occupants of the bar to be of legal drinking age. There were two subjects working the bar and neither subject was a licensed bartender. The applicant was cited for Responsible Person on Premise.

4. On 06/01/2019 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 2082 S Muskego Av for Sale of Cigarette to Minor/Underage.

5. On 09/15/2019 officers conducted a licensed premise check at El Relajo Club, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. As the officers approached they observed several people outside the building, enter the building and lock the door. The officer tried the door and found it locked. Upon knocking a security guard opened the door and reluctantly let the officer enter. The officer observed a makeshift dance floor and music being played from a laptop, through a speaker system. The officer spoke with the manager who stated the business had been approved for a PEP but he did not have the license on the premise. During the check the officer observed the rear emergency exit locked with a padlock. The manager stated he would talk with the contracted security officer regarding the locked door. On 09/20/2019 an officer spoke with the applicant by phone about the violations. The applicant stated the front door was locked because he wants to prevent patrons from coming in after 2:00am because they were closing in 30 minutes. The applicant did not have an explanation for why the emergency exit was locked.

6. On 10/18/2019 officers conducted underage tavern enforcement in District 6. An underage Police Aide attempted to gain entry to El Relajo Bar, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The Police Aide was stopped at the door and asked for ID. He was denied entry when he could not provide ID.

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Items 4 and 5 updated with disposition on 02/24/2021

7. On 01/01/2020 at 5:25am officers were dispatched to a Threat complaint at 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The caller was not on scene but stated in her call she was being threatened by the bartender. The officers spoke with the bartender, who stated a female was causing a disturbance and was kicked out by security.
8. On 07/13/2020 officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint at 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officer spoke with the victim, who stated he was dancing on the dance floor when he was hit in the head by a ceramic mug. The victim was not sure who threw the mug. The officers spoke with the bartender, who stated he did not witness the incident but called the police when requested by a patron. The bartender stated there are interior cameras that may have captured the incident but he did not have access to them.
9. On 07/26/2020 at 1:15am officers were dispatched to a Battery complaint at 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officers interviewed a victim who stated there was verbal altercation inside between two groups of females. Security kicked one group out and the victim observed them banging on the window shouting at them. Security then kicked her group out. Once outside the first group surrounded her group and fight broke out. One of the subjects was armed with a knife. Several victims were conveyed to the hospital, one with a laceration to his right torso. The officers spoke with the bartender, who stated he did not witness the incident but called the police when requested by a patron. The bartender stated there are interior cameras that may have captured the incident but he did not have access to them. He stated he would ask the owner to make a CD for the officers. Officers spoke with the agent, who stated if the police had come faster they could have prevented this incident. The officers advised him to have security monitor the outside and have disorderly patrons leave the area.
10. On 08/30/2020 at 12:25am officers were dispatched to 733 W. Oklahoma Av. for a Battery complaint. The officers interviewed the manager, Jennifer VIDRIO, who stated a patron was kicked out of the bar. As the subject was walking through the backyard he got into an argument with several subjects. The argument turned physical and the subject was knocked unconscious. The manager showed officers video of the incident but had trouble emailing the file.
11. On 09/10/2020 at 2:00pm officers conducted a license premise check at 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officers served the applicant with a Notice of Nuisance letter regarding the previous incidents. The applicant stated he has 8 interior and 8 exterior cameras with the footage being saved for 60 days. Only management has access to the video. The applicant stated he recently added extra security and now has three security guards on the weekends. The applicant was cooperative and stated he wanted to be a positive business in the community.
12. On 09/12/2020 at 1:13am officers were dispatched to a Noise Nuisance at El Relajo bar, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. When the officer arrived they observed about 10 people standing outside talking. They asked the subject why they were outside and they stated the door was locked

and they were not being allowed inside. The officers knocked on the door and were allowed in by the manager. He stated they have been declared a Nuisance so they are limiting the patron inside the business. The music inside was being played at a loud volume and the officers advised the manager to turn it down. The officer advised to have security at the door to limit patrons, but to not lock the door as that is a safety hazard.

13. On 09/19/2020 at 1:01am officers were dispatched to a Threat complaint at El Relajo bar, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officer interviewed the bartender, Jorge ECHEVARRIA, who stated a subject was trying to get in the bar but was denied because they are only allowing invited patrons in because of being declared a nuisance property. The subject made his hand into the shape of a gun and stated he was going to come back with a gun. ECHEVARRIA told the subject to leave and not return. He stated he was not afraid because it is just part of his job.
14. On 09/19/2020 at 2:30am officers were dispatched to shots fired in the area of S. 8th St and W. Oklahoma Av. The officers located 11 casing at 803 W. Oklahoma Av. The officer went to El Relajo at 733 W. Oklahoma Av and interviewed the bartender, Jorge ECHEVARRIA, who stated he did not witness the incident. The officer then viewed the surveillance video from El Relajo. The video shows patrons exiting at 2:19am and talking outside on the sidewalk. One group goes across the street and talks by a parked truck. At 2:28am the group walks back across the street to talk with the other group. The first group is then walking back across the street when two subjects stop in the street and fire shots in the air. The video shows the bartender outside facing the subjects waving his arms like he's trying to disperse the crowd. The bartender then admitted to being outside and hearing the shots but not seeing who fired the shots.
15. On 10/08/2020 a meeting was held at District 6 regarding the nuisance declaration for El Relajo, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The applicant stated he has added No Trespassing and No Loitering signs, he has added security on weekends and has started only allowing patrons in with reservations. The officers advised using the to use social media to advise patrons of the new policy and to have a hard copy of the reservation list with the security guard. The officer also suggested the applicant mail a letter to his neighbors in order to get to know them.
16. On 10/19/2020 at 10:33pm officers conducted a license premise check at 733 W. Oklahoma Av. When the officers arrived the observed there was no security at the door. They went inside and spoke to the manager and advised him they have received complaints the patrons are playing loud music and revving their engines when they leave at night. The manager stated his security has instructions to notify those people to stop and has been taking pictures of violator cars. He was advised to make announcements inside to advise people to not cause a disturbance when they leave.
17. On 11/15/2020 at 9:14pm officers conducted a license premise check at El Relajo, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officer observed one security guard working the door. They spoke with the manager, who stated they have had no problems recently but have received a complaint from neighbors of beer bottle left on the sidewalk. He stated they have started to clean up bottles outside after closing.
18. On 02/07/2021 at 1:46am officers were dispatched to El Ralajo, 733 W. Oklahoma Av for a Battery complaint. The officer interviewed a security guard, who stated three subjects got into an argument with him. One of the subjects punched the guard causing him to fall to the ground. The security guard then pepper sprayed the subjects who fled the scene. The manager stated he does not know the subjects, and they were not invited to the bar that night.

He thinks they may have come with female that was invited on Facebook. The manager was advised to only allow entry to the subject that was invited.

19. On 02/25/2021 at 12:31am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at El Relajo bar, 733 W. Oklahoma Av. The officers spoke with the security guard, who called because there were two subject that looked like they wanted to fight. Both subjects appeared to be calling friends to assist in the fight. All subject fled when the Police arrived. The officer asked if they were still only allowing patrons in if they were invited. The manager stated they were but not tonight because it was slow. The officer suggested they continue to only allow invited patron only to prevent problems like this.

20. On 03/23/21 at 6:00pm, Milwaukee Police had a "sit down" meeting with the applicant from 733 W. Oklahoma Avenue. During the meeting the applicant told officers of her improvement which include 16 digital cameras, "no Loitering" signs, obtaining security on weekends, participating in a block watch, and put "slow down" signs in front of the business.

21. On 03/25/21 at 1:52am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 733 W. Oklahoma Avenue for a trouble with subject complaint. The subject left before police arrival.

22. On 05/16/21 at 12:00am, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 733 W. Oklahoma Avenue. No violations were found.

On Tuesday, March 23, 2021, at 6:00 pm., my partner Police Officer Michael Ward and I, had a sit down meeting with El Relajo business owner Jennifer Vidrio at 733 W. Oklahoma Avenue.

Ms. Vidrio asked to meet with us to update us on how things are going with their business. Vidrio stated that they currently have 16 digital cameras located throughout the interior and exterior of the property. 6 exterior cameras and 10 interior cameras. Ms. Vidrio also stated that they placed a security camera at the front entrance door, which captures everyone who comes in and out of the bar. I also observed "No Loitering" and "No Trespassing" signs posted on their property just as their nuisance abatement plan indicated.

Ms. Vidrio stated the business is still open from Sunday though Thursday, 9p-2a and Friday and Saturday 9p-2:30 am. Ms. Vidrio stated approximately 15-20 minutes prior to closing they start advising everyone that they need to start leaving the bar. Ms. Vidrio stated security along with bar staff walks out with the patrons to insure that they do not cause a disturbance in the neighborhood. Ms. Vidrio stated they do offer a ride share program as well. Ms. Vidrio stated that on Friday and Saturday, they do have two security guards working, one near the front entrance door and one inside of the bar. Ms. Vidrio stated they are still taking online reservations, which is done through their Facebook website.

Ms. Vidrio has participated in block watch meetings, and was advised of our monthly crime and safety meeting dates as well. Ms. Vidrio did placed slow down signs in front of the business to help assist in the efforts to deter reckless driving. I also discussed with Ms. Vidrio the calls for service that has come from their location. Since the beginning of the year 1/1/2021, there has been 5 calls for service, which out of those 5 only 3 calls for service police did respond. Ms. Vidrio stated that she wants to continue to work with the Milwaukee Police Department Prosecution Unit and community to insure the business is an asset to the neighborhood. On Sunday, December 12, 2021, at approximately 2:00am., I was dispatched to a shots fired call at 733 W. Oklahoma Ave. (El Relajo Bar) located in the City and County of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I observed multiple people exiting the tavern and leaving the location. I spoke with the bar manager, (License #0209051) Jennifer VIDRIO (w/f 07-02-98), who stated inside the bar a massive fight broke out and their security could not handle it, due to the amount of people inside the establishment. In order to control the fight VIDRIO sprayed oleoresin capsicum (OC) inside the bar to disperse everyone from inside the bar. I, observed no bullet holes nor found any casings inside or outside the establishment.

Inside the establishment, I smelled and tasted a decent amount of OC sprayed in the bar. I warned VIDRIO of possible outcomes of using OC spray inside a small closed space with a large amount of people, which can cause people to panic and become injured.

Prior to this dispatched call, officers observed a large amount of people and vehicles outside the establishment with a high likelihood of the bar being over capacity.

In the past few months there has been multiple dispatched calls for service at this establishment by neighbors and third party callers, complaining about reckless driving, vehicle entries, and fights.


