follows:
Substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from Industrial Light to General Planned Development, on land located on the East Side of North Teutonia Avenue and North of West Mill Road, in the 1st Aldermanic District.
The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee ("Common Council") do ordain as follows:
Part 1. There is added to the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances ("Code") a new section to read as follows:

Section 295-907(2)(a) 0029.
(1) In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907(2) of the Code relating to the procedures and establishment of planned development districts, the Common Council approves the sub-ject General Planned Development, a copy of which is attached to this Com-mon Council File as Exhibit A which is on file in the office of the City Clerk and made a part as though fully set forth herein.

(2) The zoning map is amended to change the zoning for Parcel No. 1 and Parcel No. 2 of Certified Survey Map No. 2351, in the Southeast 1/4 of Section 24, in Township 8 North, Range 21 East, in the City of Milwaukee, Milwaukee County, Wisconsin, from Industrial Light (IL1) to General Planned Develop-ment (GPD).

(3) The requirements set forth in said (3) The requirements set forth in said general plan attached to this Common Council File as Exhibit A, constitute the zoning regulations for the area contained in such planned development district described, provided further, that the effect of the approval of such general plan is that such plan shall limit and control construction, location, use and operation of all land and structures included within the general plan to all conditions and limitations set forth in such general plan. such general plan.

Part 2. Any persons, firm, company or corporation owning, controlling, or managing any building or premises wherein or whereon there shall be placed or there exists anything in viola-tion of the terms of this ordinance; or who shall build contrary to the plans or specifications submitted to and approved by the Commissioner of the Department of City Development, or any person, firm, company or corporation who shall omit, neglect or refuse to do any act required in this ordinance shall

be subject to the penalties provided in Section 200-19 of the Code.
Part 3. In accordance with the provisions of Section 295-907(2) of the Code, the City Clerk shall transmit a certified copy of the action taken by the Common Council to the Department of City Development. of City Development

Part 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the re-maining portions. The Common Council declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion irre-spective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases or other portions be declared void or invalid.
