REASON FOR REQUEST:

Russell MacRae, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle with its emergency lights and siren activated and traveling eastbound on West Center Street. The uninsured motorist, who was traveling northbound on North Martin Luther King Drive, disregarded the red traffic signal at the intersection of West Center Street and North Martin Luther King Drive, striking the City vehicle and causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer MacRae sustained injuries to his head and neck. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$18,969.54.
