You are hereby notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on September 26, 2006 commencing at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202 to consider your Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) license with change of entertainment application for the premises located at 618-24 North Broadway in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Jungle").

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Licenses Committee which includes its Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending a suspension of the Class "B" Tavern and Tavern Amusement Cabaret (Nite Club) with change of entertainment license for ninety (90) days. The recommendation is the result of a public hearing before the Committee held on September 11, 2006, a police report and neighborhood objections.

You may file a written objection to the Report of the Licenses Committee. If you file a written objection to the report of the Licenses Committee, you may also appear before the Milwaukee Common Council to make oral arguments supporting your written objections and present oral arguments supporting that objection to the Common Council. Any written objections to the Committee's Report must be filed with the City Clerk at least three (3) working days prior to the above-mentioned date set for hearing by the Common Council. You or a legal representative may then also appear at the Common Council meeting and request an opportunity to address the Common Council for approximately five (5) minutes to present an oral argument on your own behalf.
