Dear Committee Members:

Enclosed for your consideration, please find a resolution regarding the abovenoted matter, and appropriate fiscal note.

The Estate of Edward Pundsack, his wife, his child and his father brought a civil suit against the City of Milwaukee, former Chief Arthur Jones and Sergeant Mark Wagner, relative to the shooting death of Edward Pundsack, which occurred on or about December 23, 2002. In short, Sergeant Wagner maintains that he was forced to fire his weapon at Mr. Pundsack, and thus employ deadly force, because he perceived that Mr. Pundsack was posing a threat to his life, and the lives of other officers, by his use of his motor vehicle. Plaintiffs maintain that the sergeant was unreasonable in his use of force.

This matter was presented to the Judiciary and Legislation Committee, in closed session, on January 29, 2007. The Committee approved settlement of this case for \$50,000.00.
